The symposium will coincide with the launch of the public art exhibition **Artful Fare: Conversations About Food**, featuring the collaborative art projects of KPU Fine Arts and English students as they engage in creative-critical dialogues about Canadian poetry. **Vancouver Poet Laureate Rachel Rose** will present a Creative-Keynote on the topic of poems inspired by food.
