Portfolio Package Prep

The Wilson School of Design at KPU uses an online submission portal, SlideRoom, to collect, evaluate, and store portfolios. Once you have completed your online application to KPU, you will receive instructions from our Admissions team on how to submit your portfolio. This portfolio presents your potential to work in the field of interior design so you are encouraged to show a variety of work.

As part of your online submission, you will be asked to:

1. **Upload a short video***
2. **Upload a Resumé/CV**
3. **Attach Unofficial Transcripts** (*as applicable*)
4. **Submit 1-3 Letter(s) of Reference**
5. **Upload your Portfolio** (*showing a variety of creative work*)

Only applicants who meet the application, documentation, and portfolio submission requirements will be contacted for an online interview. For more detailed information on the portfolio package as outlined above, please visit our website.
