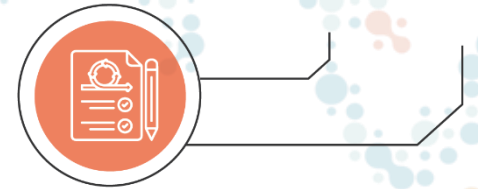
COSTS TO BE COVERED BY THE PARTICIPANT

The student is responsible for covering the following expenses:

- Round trip air transfer to and from Guanajuato International Airport (BJX)
- International Medical Insurance
- Personal expenses during your stay
- Accommodation and meals*

*From the group of students accepted to the program, a selection will be made to receive complementary support for lodging and food expenses during the second half of the program. All students accepted to the program are automatically considered to compete for this scholarship without the need to integrate a new application file.

*All participants are requested to plan to have sufficient means for living expenses before travelling to the city of Guanajuato since support will not be granted to all participants.

INFORMATION TO APPLY

Each partner Higher Education Institution must send the following documents of to internacional@ugto.mx:

NOMINATION DOCUMENTS

1. Letter of nomination from the international office with full name and e-mail address, indicating that the student is academically recommended to conduct research.
2. Motivation letter with signature and date, indicating the area of studies of interest to research during the UG Research program 2024.
3. Copy of valid passport (photo sheet).
4. Students are required to submit a copy of international medical insurance policy with the following coverage to receive their acceptance letter: Minimum hospitalization coverage of \$100,000 USD (unlimited coverage is recommended), legal advice (civil liability), emergency evacuation and transfer, repatriation of remains, displacement of a family member, coverage for COVID-19 disease and the expenses of the medical consequences of the disease.

Note: nominations with incomplete documents or after the deadline will not be received.

STEPS:

ELECTRONIC REGISTRATION

Those students whose official nomination is accepted will receive an email with a username and password to register on the electronic platform of the DRICA. The students must complete their registration before March 8, 2024. A second registration in <https://intraug.ugto.mx/> will be requested to be completed before March 8, 2024, as well.

ASSIGNMENT TO A RESEARCH GROUP

As of April 26, 2024, students who have completed their DRICA electronic registration could be part of the research team of a professor from the University of Guanajuato, assigned according to their preferred area of study mentioned in the self-presentation essay and motivation letter. This information will be received by each student by e-mail.

REGISTRATION IN RESEARCH TEAM

Students who are part of a research group must accept the research project assigned on the platform of the Office of Research and Postgraduate Support (DAIP).

LETTER OF ACCEPTANCE

Students are required to submit a copy of international medical insurance policy with the requested coverage and vaccination card in their electronic DRICA profile to receive their acceptance letter to the Summer Research Program.
