Looking for an enthusiastic, fun, and motivated Behaviour Interventionist for a happy 4-year-old boy diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder. Our program is intensive and very typical of an early ABA program consisting of teaching many skills such as imitation, following instructions, language development and social/play skills.

Training will be provided by a board-certified behavior consultant, Leanne Schniedel. You must be able to work 2 sessions per week which can be: Saturday and Sunday between 8am and 12pm as well as Sunday between 4pm-6pm. There can also be opportunities to pick up shifts from one of our other 3 BIs if they need an evening off as they are all in school. Sessions will be 2 hours and can be selected in the times mentioned. You also need to be able to attend team meetings which are on the second Friday of every month from 4pm-6pm.

- be able to provide criminal record check (within last 12 months)
- the desire to make a difference in a child's life
- have great fondness for kids and great passion for his/her job
