High School

- Proof of June graduation must be received in order to be eligible for Fall admission.
- Students graduating in August are eligible for Spring admission.
- Students graduating in January are eligible for Summer admission.

Transfer

• College/university transcripts from all institutions attended (regardless of whether you intend to transfer your credits to KPU).

Mature

High school records showing highest level of completion.

Aboriginal

Supplemental applicant package reviewed by Aboriginal Admissions Committee.

STEP 3 - English upgrading and 2 undergraduate courses



CHANGES TO PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Online Portfolio Submission

- All Wilson School of Design programs now accept portfolios through an online platform
- Students will only be given access after submitting their KPU application
- There is a \$5-12 fee required by the student to use the online platform

Online Information Sessions

- These programs now offer an online method to satisfy the program information session requirement
- Students will only be given access after submitting their KPU application
- Students must successfully answer 5-10 questions at the end of the video
 - Health Care Assistant
 - Health Unit Coordinator
 - Computer Aided Design & Drafting
