HELP! THE CLASS I WANT IS FULL

TIP 1

Try to waitlist for the section that has the greatest number of waitlist seats open. For example, if a section says 3 out of 35 waitlists open versus 33 out of 35 waitlists open, try to waitlist for the section with 33 waitlist seats open. This will put you on waitlist position # 3.

TIP 2

Waitlist for as many classes as possible that are part of your program and for which you meet the pre-requisite/ co-requisite. The more classes you waitlist for, the more chances you have of registering for at least 9 credits needed to be a full-time student.

TIP 3

If waitlisted, check your KPU email regularly for notification of an open seat. Be mindful of the 24 hour window to register if you receive anemail regarding a seat opening up.

TIP 4

Some classes are reserved for students in a particular program. These reserves may be lifted after a certain date, after which the class becomes available to all students. You may check to see when and if a reserve will be lifted for the specific course you wish to register in at https://www.kpu.ca/registration/reserves-and-restrictions

TIP 5

If you couldn't get into a class before the term starts, trying checking for seat availability during the first week of classes. Once classes start, there is no more waitlist, but you may still register for courses if you see a seat has opened up in a class.

When to see an International Advisor?

Unfortunately, if a course is full, advisors cannot help you get into the course. Instead, International Education Advisors can help you in the following situations:

- If you need to register for one last course in order to complete your program requirements. Please note, this must be a specific course (for example, INFO 2345).
- If you want to discuss your options in case you are not able to maintain full-time status.
- If you like to have a list of courses that you should register/ waitlist for.
