



# Students who Studied in the 2019/20 Academic Year

### Headcount




## **Key Student Demographics**

complete a bachelor's degree




### **Disability & Ongoing Medical Conditions**




50% of students have a disability or ongoing condition that affects their functioning which they consider a disadvantage in their studies.

Mental health conditions such as depression and anxiety are prominent (23% of students), in addition to learning disabilities such as dyslexia (23% of students).
