









Student Enrolment Patterns

From the Fall 2020 Student Satisfaction Survey – Faculty of Health Results Of the 665 eligible Health students registered in Fall 2020, 302 (45%) responded to the survey

Disability & Ongoing Medical Conditions




24% of students have a disability or ongoing condition that affects their functioning which they consider a disadvantage in their studies.












How KPU Health Graduates Do
