




INTEREST IN A STUDENT RESIDENCE²



HOUSING NEEDS MET AND INTEREST IN A STUDENT RESIDENCE




Interest in a Student Residence

Students whose housing needs are well met tend to have shorter commutes.




INTEREST IN A STUDENT RESIDENCE IN RELATION TO HOUSING NEEDS

Students whose housing needs are poorly met tend to be more interested in a student residence.




INTEREST IN A STUDENT RESIDENCE BY STUDENTS' MAIN CAMPUS

Students at Surrey and Richmond have the greatest interest in a student residence.




INTEREST IN A STUDENT RESIDENCE FOR SELECTED LOCATIONS³
