

MAJOR ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

THE PRESIDENT'S SCHOLARSHIP - \$30,000

a. Enrolling at KPU in a four-year program

- b. 1.) 80% average in English Studies 12 and 3 other academic Grade 12 courses; or whenever necessary, averages will be calculated using final Gr.11 marks and interim Gr. 12;
- 2.) Or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- c. Demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

Conditions

- a. Enrollment in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits per semester
- b. Good academic standing with a minimum CGPA of 3.0 for the duration of the award period

Value & Quantity

a. Fall Semester Intake: Four awards (\$30,000 x 4 recipients)

\$7,500 per program year for up to four years (Fall and Spring semesters only)

b. Spring Semester Intake: Two awards (\$30,000 x 2 recipients)

\$7,500 per program year for up to four years (Spring and Fall semesters only)

THE MERIT SCHOLARSHIP - \$7,500

a. Enrolling at KPU in any program

b. 1.) 80% average in English Studies 12 and 3 other academic Grade 12 courses; or whenever necessary, averages will be calculated using final Gr.11 marks and interim Gr. 12;

2.) Or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits

c. Demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

Conditions

- a. Enrollment in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits per semester
- b. Good academic standing with a minimum CGPA of 3.0 for the duration of the award period

Value & Quantity

a. Fall Semester Intake: Twelve awards (\$7,500 x 12 recipients)

\$7,500 split over 2 terms in first year (Fall and Spring semesters only)

b. Spring Semester Intake: Six awards (\$7,500 x 6 recipients)

\$7,500 split over 2 terms in first year (Spring and Fall semesters only)



THE INDIGENOUS ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP - \$7,500

a. Must identify as Aboriginal, First Nations, Metis or Inuit

- b. 1.) 80% average in English Studies 12 and 3 other academic Grade 12 courses; or whenever necessary, averages will be calculated using final Gr.11 marks and interim Gr. 12;
- 2.) Or the equivalent of a 3.67 transfer GPA on a minimum of 24 transferable university credits
- c. Demonstrated leadership, community involvement and volunteerism

Conditions

- a. Enrollment in a minimum of 12 undergraduate credits per semester
- b. Good academic standing with a minimum CGPA of 3.0 for the duration of the award period

Value & Quantity

- a. Fall Semester Intake: Two awards (\$7,500 x 2 recipients)
 - \$7,500 split over 2 terms in first year (Fall and Spring semesters only)
- b. Spring Semester Intake: One award (\$7,500)
 - \$7,500 split over 2 terms in first year (Spring and Fall semesters only)
