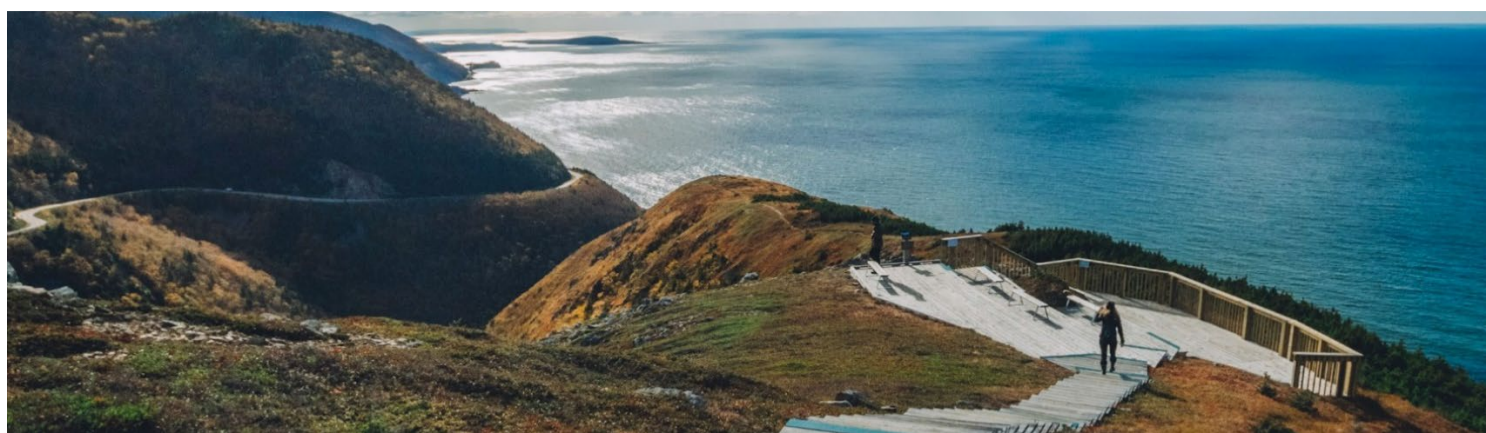

Course registration for Summer 2024!

Course registration for **Summer 2024** will open on **March 11, 2024**. To prepare for registration, check your assigned [Registration Dates & Times](#) by doing the following steps:

1. Log into the [Online Self Service \(OSS\)](#)
2. Select **Student Menu**
3. Select **Registration > Prepare for Registration**
4. Select the term from the drop-down menu

Remember to **verify your registration eligibility** and **clear any holds on your account** before your registration date! **Students are strongly encouraged to discuss their course planning with an [Academic Advisor](#)** before making decisions on course registration.
