

Please benefit from this friendly reminder that KPU courses are offered on 4 campuses, located in different cities across BC’s Lower Mainland: Richmond, Surrey, Langley and Cloverdale.

When you are registering for courses at KPU, **always check the campus location of your courses** before registering and be careful not to register for back-to-back courses on different campuses. Students who are taking KPU’s inter-campus shuttle or BC’s public transportation system (rather than driving their own car) are advised to leave **more than one hour** between courses on different campuses.

KPU courses can be scheduled to take place at any one of our 4 campuses (Surrey, Richmond, Langley, Cloverdale), so it is important to always look at the location where the course is being taught. Please plan your schedule in such a way that commutes from one campus to another are minimal and realistic.

Here are the abbreviations that you will see in the course timetable, associated with each campus:

- S= Surrey
- R= Richmond
- L= Langley
- C= Cloverdale
- A= Online
- F= Offsite

When choosing courses, from KPU’s course timetable, look under the category of “Building” to find out which campus will host the course.

**Distance and Travel Times from Campus to Campus**

With 4 campuses spread across the BC's Lower Mainland, you are advised to always check the campus location of your courses before registering and be careful not to register for back-to-back courses on different campuses. If your course plan must include registering for courses on different campuses, plan for adequate travel time between classes, keeping in mind that you may have to rely on the shuttle bus schedule, for example, to transport you from one campus to the other.

For your convenience, here is a guide to travel distance (in km) and **approximate driving time** (in minutes) between KPU campuses:

	Richmond	Langley	Cloverdale	Surrey
From Surrey to:	24.1 (25 min.)	18.9 (40 min.)	13.5 (20 min.)	-
From Langley to:	43 (50 min.)	-	6.5 (10 min.)	18.9 (40 min.)
From Cloverdale to:	36.4 (40 min.)	6.5 (10 min.)	-	13.5 (20 min.)
From Richmond to:	-	43 (50 min.)	36.4 (40 min.)	24.1 (25 min.)

Inter-campus Transportation

KPU is a multi-campus university and we are pleased to provide students, faculty and staff with shuttle bus service between the campuses. This convenient method of transportation will get you safely from one campus to another.

And it is easy to use: simply show your valid KPU Library ID card to the driver as you get onto the bus. No payment is required. *Note: You can pick up your Library ID card once you arrive at the beginning of the term.*

Note: There is no shuttle service to and from the Richmond campus. Instead, take Translink's bus 'number 301' for direct service between the Richmond and Surrey campuses.
