Visit the Amazon Rainforest of Colombia and experience first-hand the Calanoa Project. Engage in interdisciplinary, cultural and creative activities focused on sustainability, community development and conservation. Bring to your studies renewed depth, purpose and global awareness.

Highlights

Explore local materials and design. Paddle through flooded forests. Meet with local artisans and master craftspeople. Search for river dolphins by the Peruvian shore. Meet with shamans and get a glimpse into their vision of the world. Hike through tropical rainforest and boat down the Amazon River.
