Application Deadlines

Nomination procedure

The partner will be contacted to nominate students to RMIT Vietnam and Melbourne through a nomination link, where the following will need to be provided:

- Students' full name and gender
- Birth date
- Email address
- Period of study
- Courses intended to take at RMIT
- RMIT campus to which the student is selected (Melbourne, Saigon South, Hanoi)

Application procedure & required documents

Once nominated by their home institution, applicants to RMIT will receive an email with instructions on how to access the application form and the link to our online application. Nominated students can start preparing their documents as they will have to upload on the online application the following required documents:

- Your completed online application form
- Original official transcript (translated into English)
- One passport photo
- Copy of passport with bio data page
- Post-graduate students will also need to upload their Bachelor degree certificate



Students will be sent offer letters and offer acceptance forms. Students need to submit the signed acceptance forms to RMIT Vietnam - Admissions Team at admissions@rmit.edu.vn.



A health insurance may be required in order to obtain a visa. Suitable medical insurance will be arranged by RMIT Vietnam on behalf of the student. Visa Application



Procedure: Step-by-step

Step 1: After receiving the offer letter, provide these required documents via admissions@rmit.edu.vn

- Signed 'Acceptance of offer' form
- Receipt of health insurance payment (if applicable)

Step 2: RMIT Vietnam will send students the soft copy of the visa invitation letter provided by the Vietnamese Immigration Department.

Step 3: Students submit the visa invitation letter and other required documents to the Vietnamese Embassy in their home country and pay the visa fee.

Step 4: Collect the visa at the Vietnamese Embassy in their home country (The process with the Embassy may take up to 30 days).

- * International students entering Vietnam with a different visa type will be required to exit the country and enter again to get Student visa renewal/extension.
- * Only students who pay medical insurance will be processed further with visa invitation letter.

Fee

This fee is as of July 2018 for reference, with stamping fee included. Please go to the Vietnamese Embassy website in your home country for the lastest price.

- About \$50 \$55 for 3-month single entry visa
- About \$100-\$120 for 3-month multiple entry visa
- Around \$200 USD from 6 months to one year multiple entry (US/American passport holders only)

Before Students Arrive

If students are new to Vietnam we recommend that students arrive 4 weeks prior to the school's start date to have time to arrange long-term accommodation.

International students still living overseas can book their temporary accommodation prior to them leaving home by booking through Agoda or TripAdvisor. Please read carefully the review/evaluation from the past customers for reference before making the booking.

Students may want to arrange their long term accommodation before arrival, however, starting with short-stay accommodation will help them make an informed decision on location, price, safety and proximity to public transport. This gives students the opportunity to visit, explore and determine the best location for them.

When Students Arrive

We recommend them meet with our International Student Support Team and Buddy team at International Orientation Day which is normally held a week before the semester starts.

Students will get a chance to meet with RMIT staff and their buddies to get crucial information from the University and to meet with other international students so that they can find roommates then.

Buddy team can support new international students with an accommodation site check and translate the contract for long-term accommodation if needed.
