

Eagles Badminton Ranked 5th in Canada



METRO VANCOUVER, BC (November 30th, 2012) – After a successful 2011-12 campaign, where veteran Willis Kwee (Richmond) and first-year player Andy Wong (Vancouver) took home a CCAA National Bronze Medal in Men's Doubles, the Eagles badminton team have started the 2012-2013 season in strong fashion. The Pacific Western Athletic Association (PACWEST) badminton conference is one of the toughest in the country, and continues to get stronger each year. Combining the talents of veteran and first-year players, the Eagles completed the first two PACWEST tournaments in 2nd place as a team, and were recognized in the Canadian Collegiate Athletic Association's (CCAA) National Rankings this past week in 5th place.
