

Women's Eagles Double-up Against Cats



METRO VANCOUVER, BC (November 26th, 2012) – In Week #4 of PACWEST Basketball action, the Women's Eagles hosted the Columbia Bible College Bearcats in a lop-sided meeting on home court in their only game this past weekend.

The Eagles came out strong against the Columbia Bible College (CBC) Bearcats and dominated the first half of the game. Scoring 19 points in the first quarter and adding an addition 24 points in the second half, the Eagles clearly were a force on the court as the Eagles went into the half with 42 points to CBC's 18 points. The second half was a tighter match-up as the Bearcats put up 20 points and the Eagle's posted a tighter lead with 34 points. However, the damage was done in the first half and the Eagles went on to the clear victory, doubling the Bearcats in a score of 76 – 38.

Multiple Eagles posted double digits in the game, led by captain and second-year guard, Jessica Villadiego (Surrey) with an impressive 19 points, 4 rebounds and 3 steals. Third-year centre, #22 Samantha McPhail (Vancouver), followed closely behind with a great first half to notch total game stats of 14 points (70% from the paint), 7 rebounds

and 3 assists. Second-year guards, Christina Brown (Langley) and Jeannine Yngreso (Surrey) both added 10 points to the scoreboard. Brown added 4 rebounds, 2 assists and 2 steals while Yngreso added 2 assists and 3 steals. The Eagles put up a total of 27 points in three-pointers and 49 rebounds with a defensive rebound stat of 68%.

"Everyone got to play 10 or more minutes for us [tonight]," stated Head Coach, Dan Nayebzadeh. "We competed hard and did a good job executing our offense. We have a big weekend coming up on the island and we need to be prepared to work hard on the road."

This win puts the Eagles in sole possession of 4th place within the PACWEST standings after Week #4 with a .500 record (3W – 3L). The Eagles will travel to the Island this weekend to face the Camosun College Chargers on Friday, November 30th and then the Vancouver Island University Mariners on Saturday, December 1st.
