# ◆Eligibility requirements

Students who are enrolled in our partner universities, ISEP Exchange or UMAP Program A universities and were nominated by the home institution.

Students whose G.P.A. is 2.5/4.0 or higher [Partner University], 3.0/4.0 or higher [ISEP/UMAP].

Students who have a Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) score of N3 or higher or the equivalent of CEFR B2 or higher in English or who come from a university where the language of instruction is Japanese or English.



Step 2: The guidelines for submitting documents through our web system, Toyo Net-ACE, will be sent to exchange program coordinators (students from partner universities and UMAP) or students (students from ISEP) after the deadline of the online application (around October 13). Please note that the online application is just a part of the application process and students need to submit other application documents through our web system. If you do not submit the application documents by the deadline, we will take that to mean that you have declined the placement and withdrawn your application.




Step 4: Admission acceptance (PDF) will be sent to you via Toyo-Net ACE.
