Dear Faculty and Instructional staff,

We are providing another update on our Kaltura migration. The process to fixing links to media tied to Fall 2021 and Spring 2022 courses has been progressing but is not yet complete. We are working very closely with our vendor to have this work completed prior to start of the summer semester.

This is the fastest way to get your courses ready for the upcoming semester. However, if you have many videos inside your Moodle course shell, we understand this may be a lot of work and we are doing our best to mitigate additional work on your part.
