

Academic Planning and Priorities/Budget Committee (APP/B):

APP/B is a faculty of health (FoH) standing committee that supports FoH programs by advising on matters relating to vision, support and development related to fiscal priorities, processes, allocations and implications.

The committee is responsible for

- Working in collaboration with FoH programs to advise about or make decisions related to education goals, objectives, strategies, priorities, curriculum changes or program related revisions, including discontinuation.
- Recommending priorities when implementing new certificate, diploma or degree programs
- Suggest policies and processes for development, review, implementation and communication of educational plans, ensuring alignment with FoH priorities, as well as taking in to account internal and external recommendations.
- Collaborating with other FoH standing committees and KPU committees
- Budgetary: Identify and strategize funding opportunities and potential implications related to new initiatives and decisions made; Identify funding allocations

Students' Role:

- To represent the student body.
- Act in good faith and best interest of the University as a whole
- Review meeting materials prior to the meeting
- Share the student perspective by participating in discussions
