GUIDELINE

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)

This guideline applies to all FoH students enrolled in programs that require a valid CPR Basic Life Support (BLS) or HCP certificate or equivalent.

Note: HCAP students require CPR Level C only

Fit Testing (N95 Respirator Mask)

This Guideline applies to all students enrolled in FoH programs with a practice component.

PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

1. It is the student's responsibility to renew the CPR-BLS certificate or equivalent every two years, or annually if required by the practice agency policies.
2. It is the student's responsibility to be fit tested annually for a N95 Respirator Mask.
3. Students must present their valid certificate to their practice instructor at the beginning of each practice course. A copy may also be required in the student's e-Portfolio.
4. Students who cannot provide evidence of current certification will not be allowed to attend practice experiences until certification can be provided.
