



Information for a Student Representative for Faculty Council

Mandated via the BC University Act, Faculty Council (FC) is a committee that serves to be the final decision-making body for the Faculty of Health (FoH). They are involved in important decisions that affect your educational experience including but not limited to: course changes, admission criteria, student guidelines, and faculty qualifications.

Faculty Council requires a student as one of the many voting representatives and can expect to receive minutes, agendas, committee invites and information packages. Student input is encouraged and solicited especially when it pertains to your education.

Students are required to attend a two-hour monthly meeting, usually the fourth Friday of every month. There may be additional time commitments based on the required work by a student with a FC member.

Student input is valued and encouraged.
