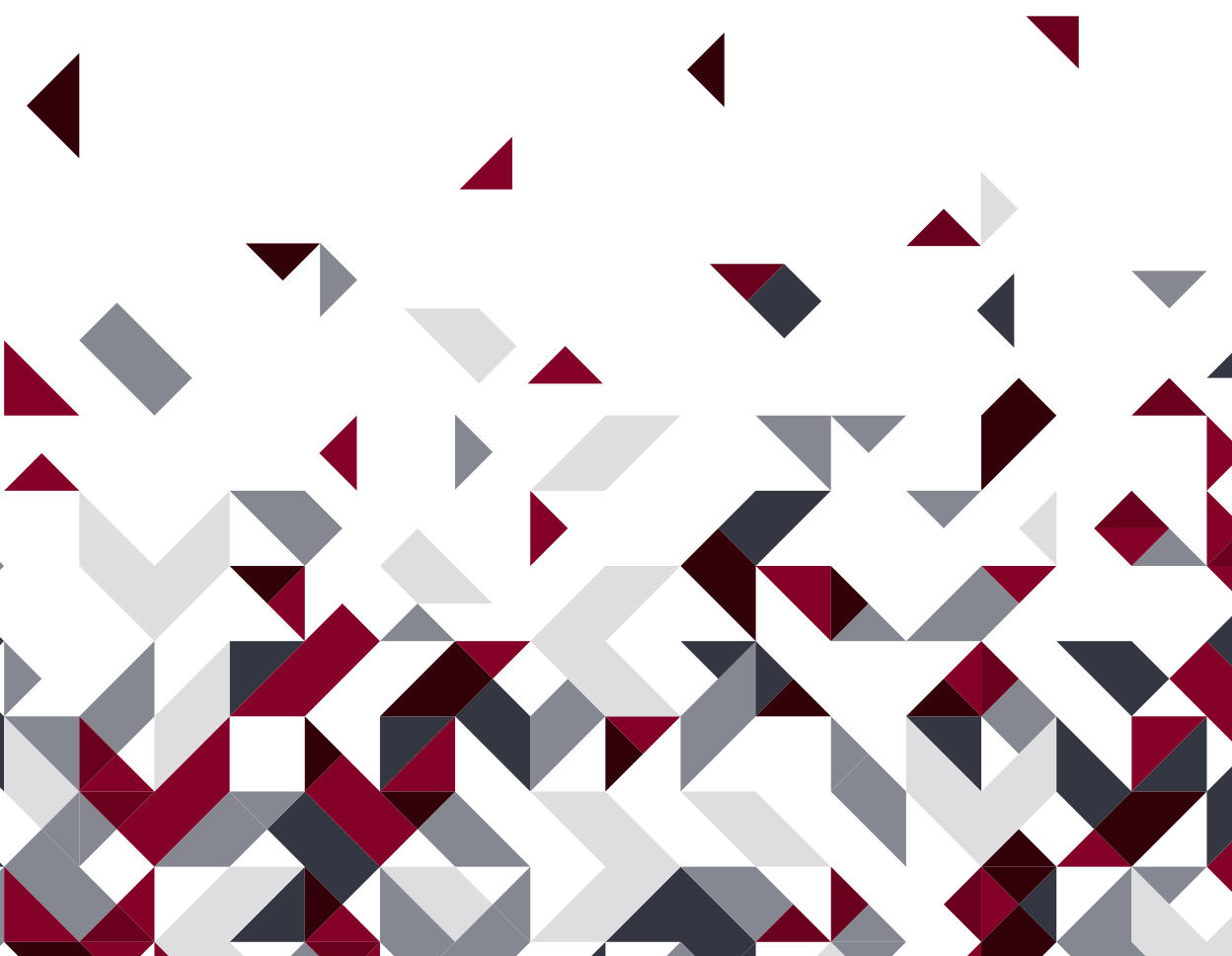

The Paddles by Brandon Gabriel

On display at convocation ceremonies are five hand-carved canoe paddles, each painted with an original Coast Salish design.

Created by Kwantlen First Nation artist Brandon Gabriel, each of the full-length paddles features artwork designed to symbolize a KPU campus — a wolf for Surrey, a beaver for Tech, a bear for Civic Plaza, a thunderbird for Richmond and an eagle for Langley.

The paddles also reflect the language and culture of the First Peoples of this region who have relied on the local rivers, lakes and seas for millennia. They are important symbols of the university's tireless effort to foster knowledge and understanding.

Brandon (Kwelexwelsten) studied at KPU and his art has been exhibited around the world. His murals, screens, sculptures, installations and graphic art can be found in dozens of schools, civic buildings, public parks and plazas. He recently co-created an eight-metre-tall mural on display at the KPU Surrey library.

American Sign Language (ASL) interpretation will be provided at all convocation ceremonies.

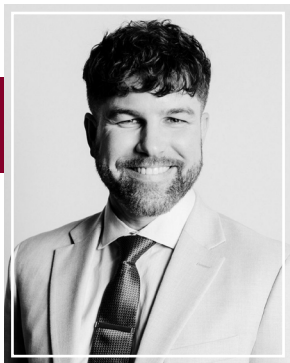

Work hard, be curious and meet people. Twelve years after graduating from KPU and launching a successful international finance career, Andrew Code offers that straightforward advice to today's graduating students.

Andrew is a director within the strategic capital markets team at PJT Partners, a global advisory-focused investment bank with key offices in New York and London and satellite offices globally, where he advises companies and shareholders on all things related to capital structures and financings.

When he enrolled at KPU, he wasn't sure what he wanted to achieve, although small class sizes, practical coursework and supportive faculty helped him find traction. A turning point came in a finance class taught by instructor Dr. Robert Ironside, who challenged Andrew to think big. Andrew took a gamble and chased the dream, paying his own way to London in hopes he could interview there. It worked, and Houlihan Lokey became Andrew's first real foothold in international finance. He was later recruited to PJT in London, where he now advises clients on everything from acquisitions and take-over financings, to leveraged buy-outs and dividend recaps.

Andrew says that few other professions offer the same combination of upward mobility, international flexibility and intellectual challenge as finance. But he also says all of that is essentially worthless unless he's enjoying the ride along the way.

Alumni Excellence Award

The Alumni Excellence Award recognizes specific accomplishments of KPU alumni, including major awards, national or international honours, major championships, appointment to high office, and so on.



Dr. Farah Rattansi

Associate of Arts, General Studies

Farah is a compassionate leader and innovator in the field of pediatric and neurodevelopmental care. Since graduating from KPU in 2013, she has dedicated her career to improving access to support for children with autism and developmental disabilities.

As the founder and clinical director of My Empower Therapy, a pediatric therapy clinic based in Surrey, B.C., Farah developed

a leading integrated model that brings together speech-language pathology, occupational therapy, behavioural intervention, counselling, and developmental supports under one organization. Under her leadership, the company has expanded to six locations across the Lower Mainland, helping reduce barriers and wait times for families seeking specialized care.

In addition to her clinical work, Farah also established the Neuro Brain Treatment Center Vancouver, focused on advancing personalized neurological and mental health treatment through evidence-based neurotechnology.

Farah’s impact also extends to the broader community through various initiatives related to education and advocacy. She has led autism awareness and support campaigns, conducted free screenings, created speech therapy workshops and more. She is also actively involved in numerous organizations in her field, including the Society for Social Work and Research, Autism BC and Wave Neuroscience.

Her work has been recognized with multiple awards at both the local and international scale, including two International Stevie Awards for Women in Business and a Surrey Women in Business Award.

Outstanding Young Alumni Award

The Outstanding Young Alumni Award recognizes KPU alumni under the age of 30 who have demonstrated sustained levels of community service while making a significant or innovative impact in their chosen profession. Recipients lead with purpose and have maintained involvement with KPU or alumni activities since graduation.



Argel Monte de Ramos

Diploma in Arts, General Studies

Argel is a Filipino-Canadian singer-songwriter, actor, playwright and producer who has dedicated his career to advocating for representation and creating inclusive spaces in the performing arts.

Originally from the Philippines, Argel immigrated to Canada at the age of 15. Following his high school graduation, he enrolled at KPU, where he became actively involved in various campus initiatives, including serving as a student ambassador for the Future Students’ Office and an orientation team leader.

Uncertain of which path he wanted to pursue, Argel explored a number of different subjects through KPU’s general studies program. It wasn’t until he took an Interdisciplinary Expressive Arts class that he discovered his passion for storytelling, and decided to pursue it with dedication. After graduating from KPU, he went on to pursue a Bachelor of Performing Arts at Capilano University, graduating with distinction as class valedictorian.

Throughout his career, Argel has received several accolades for his work, including being named a top 10 finalist in **CBC Music’s Toyota Searchlight**, an Excellence Award by a BIPOC Artist at the Fraser Valley Music Awards, and an OVATION! Award for his performance in *Elf! The Musical*.

He also co-created a writing and performance initiative called The Parallel Project, which commissions monologues by and for IBPOC artists to address systemic gaps in theatre training and representation.

Argel currently works with Arts Umbrella, a not-for-profit arts education centre that provides accessible arts programming for children and youth across Metro Vancouver.

Convocation Traditions



KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY

Heraldry

The Arms of Kwantlen Polytechnic University were presented at a ceremony on May 4, 1999 by the Right Honourable Romeo LeBlanc, Governor General of Canada.

The centre shield features 'The Spirit of KPU' emblem comprising a wolf, a salmon, and a river azure as styled by Brandon Gabriel.

At the top of the blue shield, on the left side a lion and on the right a tiger facing each other in the rampant position (upright on one hind leg with forelegs outstretched as if attacking). And at the bottom of the blue shield, on the left a jaguar and on the right a Chinese dragon also facing each other in the rampant position. All are gold.

At the top in the centre, there is an open book with silver or white pages, bindings in gold and on top of it, a gold horizontal (in fess) rectangle (billet) with square bites taken out of the long sides (bretessed). In modern heraldry, this item is meant to represent a computer chip.

The crest appears above the shield, and is supported by a silver and blue twisted fabric wreath. The upper rim is set with a simple silver crown, the upper edge decorated with four salmon, looking at each other in pairs.

Supporting the arms is a green grassy mound, scattered with gold Douglas Fir cones. The mound is rising from wavy horizontal bands of blue and silver. This is the traditional heraldic representation of water - either river or ocean.

On the left is a gold female deer with blue hooves, and her bottom half is a silver fishtail with gold fins. Around her neck is a wreath of twisted silver and blue cloth. Hanging from the wreath is a green disk with an open book on it—the pages are silver; the cover is gold.

On the right is a gold eagle with a silver head, with blue talons and beak. Around his neck is a wreath like the doe's and hanging from it is a green disk with the heraldic representation of a gold computer chip.

The motto reads: Through Tireless Effort, Knowledge and Understanding.



University Mace

The mace was originally a weapon during the medieval period, and came to be associated with the prowess and strength of the knight. Today the mace is a symbol of the University's authority to award degrees and diplomas. It indicates the seriousness of convocation as the University's most important academic ceremony, and is a confirmation of the University's integrity as an academic institution. The mace is carried by a mace-bearer, who leads the processional of faculty and students in to and out of the venue where

convocation is held. The mace is usually between four feet and six feet in length and will incorporate the history and tradition that surround the vision for the University.

An academic mace symbolizes the authority vested in the chancellor to confer university credentials. This is why the mace is an integral part of convocation.

Maces are often commissioned to commemorate a milestone anniversary or presidential inauguration. Typically an artist is selected for the honour to develop a highly symbolic design that incorporates the University's traditions.

KPU's mace was carved by Kwantlen First Nation artist Drew Atkins.

KPU Parchments

New Kwantlen Polytechnic University (KPU) graduates will now receive graduation parchments featuring the Indigenous language spoken by the Kwantlen First Nation.

KPU is among the first universities in Canada to offer students an Indigenous language parchment, in addition to the English versions graduates already receive. The new parchments will feature a blend of English and hən̓q̓əmin̓əm̓ (pronounced HUN-kuh-MEE-num).

hən̓q̓əmin̓əm̓, also known as a Down River dialect of the Halkomelem language, is the language spoken by people of the Kwantlen, Katzie, Tsawwassen, Kwikwetlem, and Musqueam First Nations on whose traditional unceded territories KPU is situated. KPU is also located on the traditional unceded territories of the SENĆOŦEN-speaking Semiahmoo First Nation.

Fern Gabriel, a member of Kwantlen First Nation and hən̓q̓əmin̓əm̓ language teacher with Langley School District, used her expertise to translate the parchment text.

KPU is committed to advancing reconciliation and weaving Indigenous knowledge, values, and representation into the institution. Embedding the hən̓q̓əmin̓əm̓ language in parchments is one more way the university is encouraging various communities to learn the traditional language of the territories and respect the land-based Nations.

The hən̓q̓əmin̓əm̓ language is being included in more places around KPU. It can already be found at student service counters, and on campus building signs, and is being added to some institutional documents.

Regalia

Not until they slip into their regalia do many graduands realize the significance of their convocation ceremony. For family and friends, the first glimpse of the graduand in cap and gown heralds a milestone in the life of their loved one.

Standard for Academic Dress

At KPU, all graduates wear a black gown of Oxford shape and a black cap, or mortar board. All students wear a black tassel on their mortar board, and the tassel hangs to the left of the cap. Graduates of our bachelor's degree programs wear hoods in the Aberdeen style, made of black pilgrim cloth and bordered with a one-half inch border. The border of each hood is a specific colour that identifies a particular area of study.

Honorary Degrees: KPU Colours

Honorary Degree recipients wear a black gown of an Oxford shape and a black cap, or mortar board with a black tassel with a custom cover featuring the circle Salmon and Wolf Art in Charcoal and Grey. Honorary graduates are provided a custom hood by KPU featuring the circle Salmon and Wolf Art in Charcoal and Grey.
