# **Funding Opportunities**

## Info Sheet

For employers who are looking to hire students, there are a number of different wage subsidies available that can help cover the cost of expenses. These subsidies can be divided up by a number of factors:

#### **Student Wage Placement Program (SWPP)**

The Government of Canada distributes funding for hiring students via Employer Delivery Partners, who are "associations and organizations that represent the interests of employers in industries". Wage subsidies that are distributed by these organizations have specific criteria that is put in place by the government.

### **Industry-Specific Funding**

Most wage subsidies are industry-specific and can be applied for organizations who are industry stakeholders and/or industry-adjacent<sup>2</sup> stakeholders.

#### **Program-Specific Funding**

Most wage subsidies are intended for hiring students engaged in a work-integrated learning (WIL) program at their university or college. WIL is defined as "a form of curricular experiential education that formally integrates a student's academic studies with quality experiences within a workplace or practice setting". Student hires may or may not have to be in a program related to the industry focus of the wage subsidy.

### **Funding Distribution Method**

Most wage subsidies work by reimbursing the employer for the wage costs of the student after the work term is over. A few funding sources work differently, either as tax breaks, one-time grants, or something entirely different.
