| Admission to undergraduate (Bachelor level) classes | Student must have completed a minimum of one year of studies before starting their exchange semester at HTW Berlin. | |
| Admission to graduate (Master level) classes | Students must have completed the Bachelor's program relevant to the academic field. | |
| | In addition to the standard application documents, students applying for a Design study program, must submit a portfolio covering recent relevant works and a motivational letter. | |
| Admission to Design classes | Students applying for the Horizon study program "Sustainable Clothing/Apparel Technology (Bachelor)" must have studied in an engineering program for a minimum of 4 semesters prior to coming to HTW Berlin. | |
| Language Skills and German Language Courses | | |
| Languages of instruction | German and English (depending on study programs) | |
| Level of German language required for admission to courses taught in German | B2 (upper intermediate) | |
| Level of English language required for admission to courses taught in English | International Business: C1 All other programs taught in English: B2 | |
| Proof of language proficiency | The sending institution is responsible for ensuring the required language level. Students must provide a written proof of their language skills, which may be issued by the sending institution. | |

| Insurances | | |
| All students | must register with a public German health insurance company and have them sent their insurance status (M10) electronically to HTW Berlin. This applies to non-EU as well as EU students are recommended to sign up for personal liability insurance and travel insurance. | |
| Immigration / Residents' Registration | | |
| All students | must have a valid ID card and/or passport for the entire duration of their stay must register at the Citizens' Office within 14 days of arrival. | |
| Non-EU students | must register at Municipal Immigration Office. | |
