- Schedule regular advising appointments, and keep in touch with your Arts Degree Advisor
- Ask questions, seek support, and access university resources
- Take notes during advising appointments
- Follow through on recommendations made in your advising appointments
- Establish relationships with faculty and other mentors on campus

- Encourage and support you in setting and achieving your academic goals
- Create a safe environment in which we maintain confidentiality and respect your privacy
- Clarify academic requirements, university policies, and regulations related to your Arts bachelor degree (using the University Calendar, My Action Plan, etc.)
