In order to search for and participate in most research studies, you will need an online account with the Kwantlen Research Pool System (RPS). Using this system, you will be able to sign up for different studies and track your progress easily from the web.

*Remember that the last day to complete studies is on **April 7th 2026**

What is the Psychology Research Pool?

The Psychology Research Pool is a secure place where confidential information, such as personal details of participants, is kept. Promoting research studies, recruiting participants, recording participation credits and booking research space are the primary tasks of the Psychology Research Pool.

What are the advantages of participating in research studies?

Participating in different research studies can give you valuable, first-hand experience with psychological research, furthering your understanding of the methods of psychology. Through participation, you may meet potential research supervisors, and brainstorm ideas for future research projects. In addition, depending on your instructor, you may be able to earn bonus credits toward your courses.

**Please check your course outline for the deadline as some professors/course instructors may want to receive students' participation records early.*

1) Please use your student ID number as your account user ID.
2) KPU student email address ends in _email.kpu.ca (firstname.lastname@email.kpu.ca).
3) If you already have an account from a previous semester, you can now log in using your student ID number and your old password.
Your username has been changed by the admin, YOU DO NOT NEED TO SIGN UP AGAIN. If you have trouble signing in, please email psychresearchpool@kpu.ca.
4) Non-KPU Student (Community Participant) please create a User ID using your Last Name and the last 4 digits of your phone number (Your User ID will only be visible to the researchers of this study you sign up to participate in).

- 3) Enter the information requested by the online form:

- **User ID**
 - Use your KPU email address as your account user ID. You do not have to enter the email address domain. For example, Mary Thompson's KPU email address is mary.thompson12@student.kpu.ca. She should put down “mary.thompson12” as user ID.

- 4) Once you create your account, a password will be emailed to your email account within a minute. You may change your password after you log in.

- If you don't see this email, check junk mail (spam) filters configured for your email, please configure the filters to accept email from kwantlen-admin@sona-systems.net, as emails from the system will often be sent from that address.
- If the email is not in junk mail, and you still do not receive it within 30 minutes, please email the administrator at psychresearchpool@kpu.ca.

Most studies require you to sign up ahead of time. You will be able to view all the available timeslots for a study, and select one that is convenient for you. **For online studies, you still have to sign up from SONA in order to participate for course credits (aka bonus points).**

The latest you can cancel a study is also at 5pm, the day before your scheduled time. Please note that if you have 3 unexcused no-shows for a study appointment, you will no longer be able to participate in any more studies. Depending on the circumstances, your privileges may be reinstated.

If you have participated in a study before, you will not be able to participate in it again. If you are not sure whether this is the case, feel free to contact either of the psychology labs.
