#### Quorum was confirmed.

**1.** An update was provided by Joe Sass on both the current budget and projections for next year. The following points were noted:

According to Balanced Budget Legislation, no deficits are allowed, and revenue must exceed expenses.

Government grants are down in terms of real dollars from 5 years ago, as the amount has remained essentially the same. There is no growth in revenues except in tuition and ancillary fees. Revenue from international students is almost flipped from 5 years ago in comparison to revenue from domestic students. KPU is currently at 60% from international students.

Domestic enrolment has remained static over the past 5 years, while international enrolment has grown. This causes problems in the entire KPU ecosystem. Revenue next year is projected to provide a very low margin of error in spending because we need to grow in various infrastructure to support the increase in enrolment.

## a. Chair's Report

Dean noted that the Surrey Open House is this Saturday Feb 24. Thanks to all participants from FSH.

Paul Richard will be giving the next Science World lecture on Poo March 6<sup>th</sup> The initial plan to create a Faculty of Graduate Studies is leaning more towards an Office of Graduate Studies which is the current trend. An Office would be administered by a Director rather than a Dean. The academic decisions would be filtered through a Senate Committee on Graduate Studies with representation form all Faculties. The K-12 workshop held last week was excellent and addressed many concerns over how the curriculum changes would affect First year entrance and courses.

## c. Senate Report -

SSCC is looking into issues regarding some Pathways courses. Faculties have identified courses and essentially rubber stamped them, but students have not been successful in some courses, so the committee will be looking at the parameters and discussing who would approve changes in which courses qualify as Pathways courses.
