



STUDENT CARD

How to Get a KPU Card

- » Apply online using the <u>KPU Card Submission Form</u> for students and employees to submit their photo online. You will be able to submit your personal photo to the library online through the form
- » Wait for an email from the Library that states your card is ready to pick up. KPU Cards must be picked up in person.
- » Visit a Service Desk at the campus library you selected anytime during <u>Library open hours</u>. Don't forget to bring government issued photo ID.

Currently registered students are eligible to submit for their KPU Card 1 month before their classes begin. Requests submitted early will not be processed until 1 month before classes begin.

PARKING

Visitor & Daily Parking

Rates:

- » \$1.00 for 30 minutes to a maximum of 90 minutes
- » \$5.00 for all-day

When purchasing a Daily Parking Pass, you will be required to enter your license plate number. You are not required to display the receipt in your vehicle when parking on the campus where the pass was purchased.


Payment Methods:






