When: July 1st – July 22th, 2012




Why Should You Go?




















Travel

Flight for the Global Health Field School

Given that each student has unique circumstances, we are giving students the option to book their own flights.

We will identify a group flight that students can join with Kwantlen faculty or they can make alternate arrangements as long as they arrive at the expected meeting points on time. Students may decide to stay in Japan for personal travel at the end of the trip.

Costs

- The program fee for the Indian Field school is \$ 1200 and covers in country travel, accommodation, meals, This does not include your flight, tuition,, and personal expenses.
- A deposit of \$500 will be required at the time of application and is non-refundable. The \$500 deposit will go toward the \$1200 fee.

The outstanding amount owing will be due in two installments:

April 1, 2012: \$500

April 24, 2012: Remaining \$200

A minimum of 11 students will be required for a Field School before it can go ahead. If the program is cancelled due low enrolment, your \$500 deposit will be refunded.



Scholarships and Awards

Students are able to apply for the Student Educational Enhancement Fund which is up to \$500 for expenses related to your studies that are outside of regular tuition and fees.

Students are also able to apply for the One World International Scholarships which are awards of \$1,000 - \$3,500. Application details will be available in the Spring



Student Loans

If you are currently on student loans you may submit a reassessment to add the extra study period to the original study period by adjusting the end date if you enroll in a minimum of 9 credits.

If you are not currently on student loans you will need to enroll in a minimum of 9 credits with at least 3 of those credits running from May/Aug or 3 credits condensed July/Aug 2013.



Eligibility Requirements

You need to be:

- Nineteen years of age
- A student in good standing
- Completed 60 university credits

You do not need to:

currently be a Kwantlen student to attend



Application Process

- 1. Students will need to fill out an application form and hand it in to the Office of International Students and Scholars with their \$500 deposit
- 2. Deposit cheques should be made out to Kwantlen Polytechnic University with a note: Global Health Field School (India) and student #.
- Application form consists of general information page and a statement of interest.
- 4. Application deadline:
 - 1. February 15th, 2013
