

KWANTLEN POLYTECHNIC UNIVERSITY
SUMMER 2010, 2011 AND 2012 COMPARISON GLOSSARY AND HIGHLIGHTS

Data included in the Summer 2010, 2011 and 2012 comparison were extracted from the Kwantlen Business Intelligence Tool (KBIT) for Enrolment Data.

Summer Terms

Summer 2010: includes course registrations with a start date between May 1, 2010 and August 31, 2010

Summer 2011: includes course registrations with a start date between May 1, 2011 and August 31, 2011

Summer 2012: includes course registrations with a start date between May 1, 2012 and August 31, 2012

The only exceptions are Trades courses, which start between April 1 and July 31 of the respective summer year.

All headcounts are **FTE countable registrations** (include stayed registered and withdrawals past stable date).

Faculty headcounts are based on student program current faculty - the faculty the student program belongs to as of Summer 2012.

Student Type (New/Continuing): Students are classified as New if they do not have any academic history records in the five years prior to their current Summer registration.

Student Service Type (Domestic/International): A Student is classified as International if the fee code in the student record is "INTER" (paying international tuition rates) or "EXCH" (exchange).

Student Time Status (FT/PT): Students are classified as full-time (FT) if they are taking 12 or more credits or if they are registered in a trade term (26/27).

Age Group: The student's age group at the start of the Summer term.

Primary Residence: The following cities were grouped together in these categories:

Abbotsford: includes Chilliwack, Agassiz, Clearbrook, Sardis, Yarrow, Vedder and Cultus Lake

Burnaby: (solo)

Coquitlam: includes Port Coquitlam, Port Moody, Anmore and Belcarra

Delta: includes Ladner and Tsawwassen

Langley: includes Fort Langley and Aldergrove

New Westminster: (solo)

Richmond: (solo)

Ridge Meadows: includes Pitt Meadows and Maple Ridge

Surrey: includes White Rock and Cloverdale

Vancouver: includes East, West and North Vancouver

Other: includes all cities not referenced above

Unspecified: indicates that city of residence is not available

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Highlights

In comparing summer 2010 and 2011 to 2012:

Overall student enrolment increased by 10% over 2010 and by 9% over 2011

International students enrolment increased by 21% over 2010 and by 13% over 2011

Full time students enrolment was down by 16% over 2010 and by 11% over 2011

New students enrolment increased by 12% over 2011

Enrolment in baccalaureate programs went up by 61 % over 2010 and by 27% over 2011
