## Nomination

All students should be nominated by the international coordinator of the home institution.

- Nomination deadline Fall semester (Sept- Jan) May 1st
- Nomination deadline Spring semester (Feb-Jun) November 1st

#### **Application procedure**

Students can apply through our online application system. When the application is complete, the students will be registered then receive a login name and password.

- Application deadline Fall semester (SEPT-JAN) May 15th
- Application deadline Spring semester (FEB-JUN) November 15th

#### Studyload

We require students to follow a minimum of 22,50 ECTS and a maximum of 32 ECTS per semester.

#### Accomodation

### **Dutch grading system**

A student's workload (both contact hours and hours spent studying and preparing assignments) is measured in ECTS credits. According to Dutch law one credit represents 28 hours of work and 60 credits represent one year of full time study. The grading system has remained the same for several decades: the scale is from 1 (very poor) to 10 (outstanding). The lowest passing grade is 5.5; 9's are seldom given and 10's are extremely rare. Sometimes decimal grades are used (e.g. 7.8).
