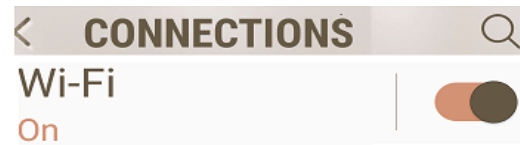
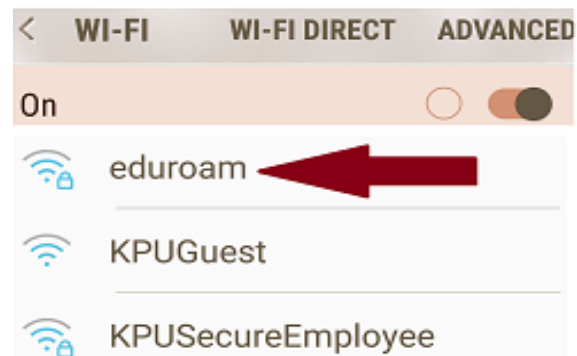


Connecting to eduroam with Android

1. Tap the **Settings** icon, and pick Wi-Fi.



2. **Select eduroam** from the list of available networks.



3. Scroll down until you see the Identity and Password text fields.

Students: Enter your KPU email address (ending with @email.kpu.ca) as your Identity. Enter your KPU password in the password field. Tap **Connect**.

Employees: Enter your KPU email address (ending with @kpu.ca) as your Identity. Enter your password. Tap **Connect**.

5. You should be returned to your list of Wi-Fi networks, and successfully connected to the eduroam network.
