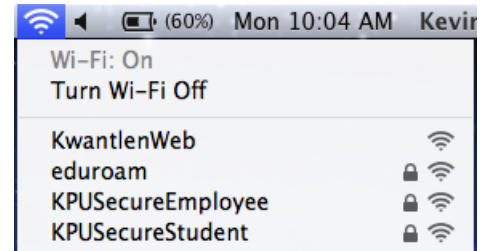


Connecting to eduroam with OS X

1. In the menu bar, click **Turn Wi-Fi On**.



2. You will see a resulting list of Wi-Fi networks. Select the **eduroam** network.



3. You will be prompted for login credentials.

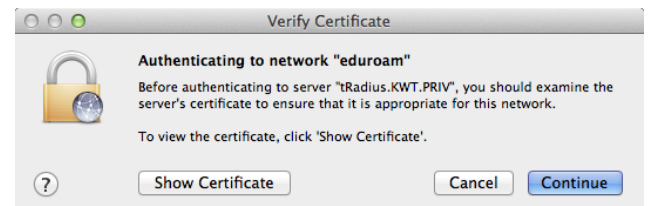
Students: Enter your KPU email address (ending with @email.kpu.ca) as your username. Enter your PIN in the password field. Click **Join**.



Employees: Enter your KPU email address (ending with @kpu.ca) as username. Enter your password. Click **Join**.



4. You may be asked to verify the certificate. If so, click **Show Certificate**.

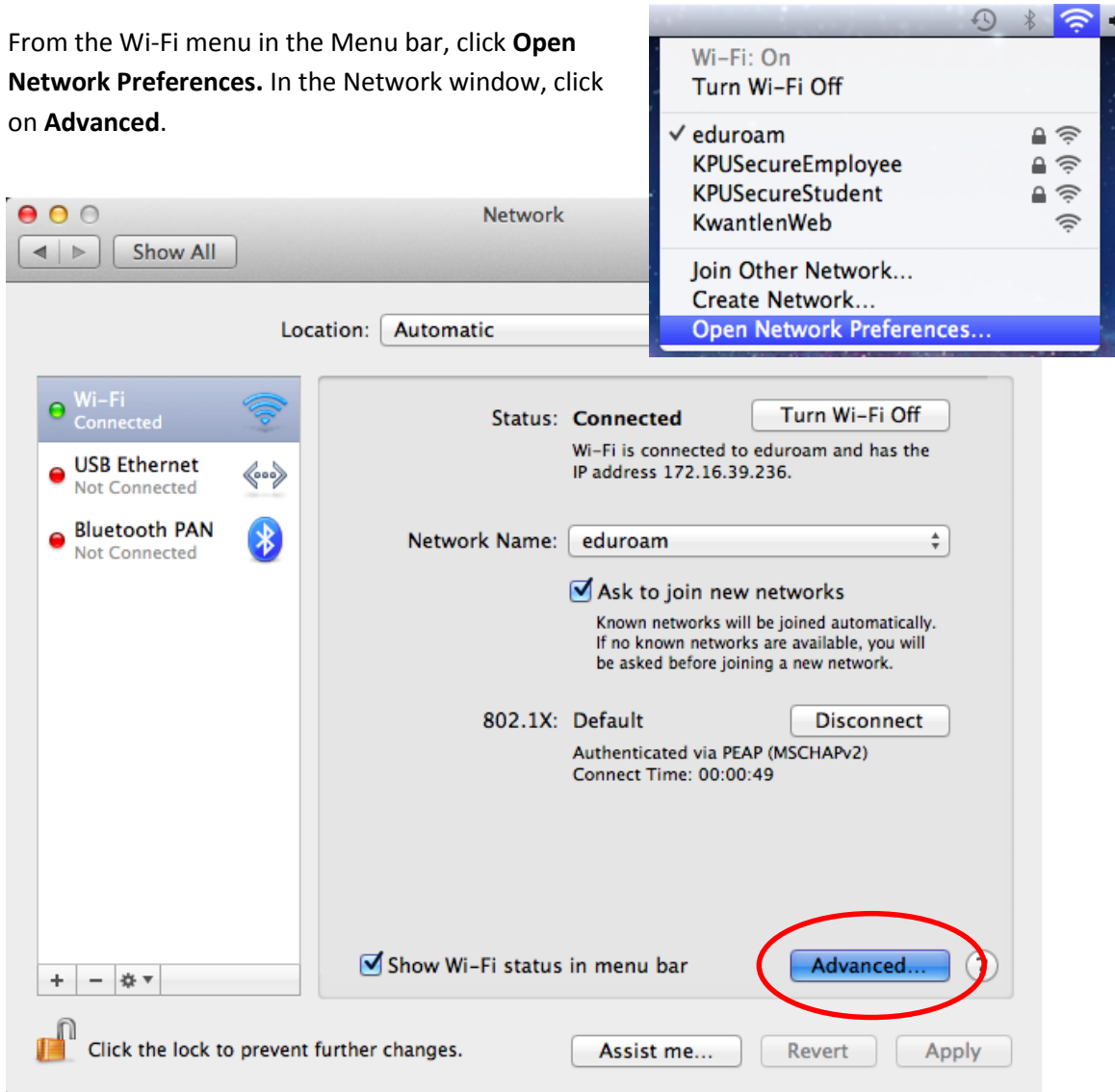


5. Ensure that the certificate was issued by DigiCert, and provided to **sac-radius-01.kpu.ca**, **sac-radius-02.kpu.ca**, or **rc-raddius-01.kpu.ca**. If it was, click **Continue**.

6. Enter your name and password to update your Certificate Trust Settings. Click **Update Settings**.



7. From the Wi-Fi menu in the Menu bar, click **Open Network Preferences**. In the Network window, click on **Advanced**.



8. Drag eduroam below the KPUSecure network(s), so your Mac will only connect to eduroam if the other networks are unavailable.
