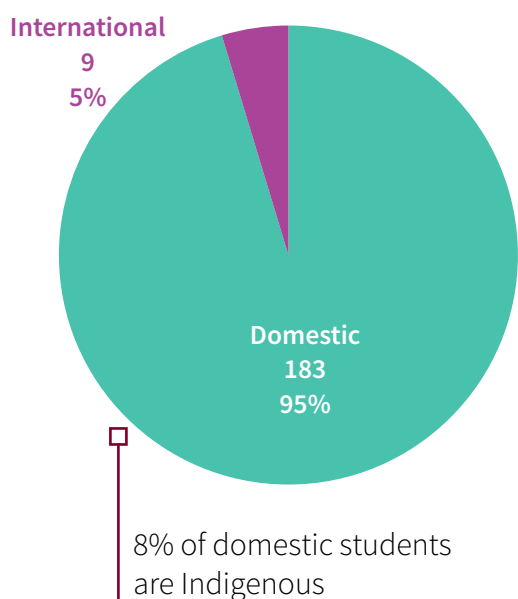


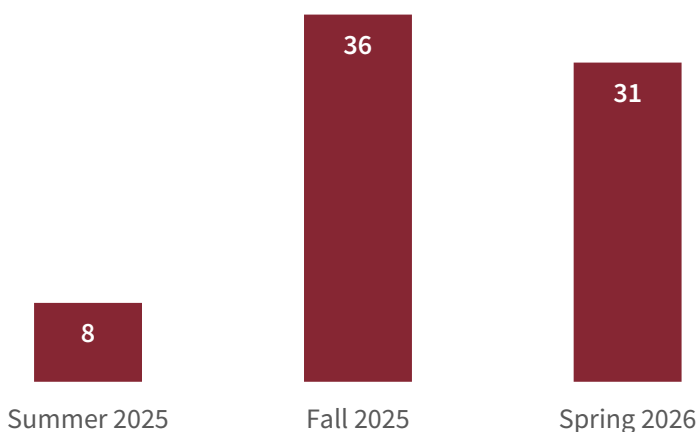

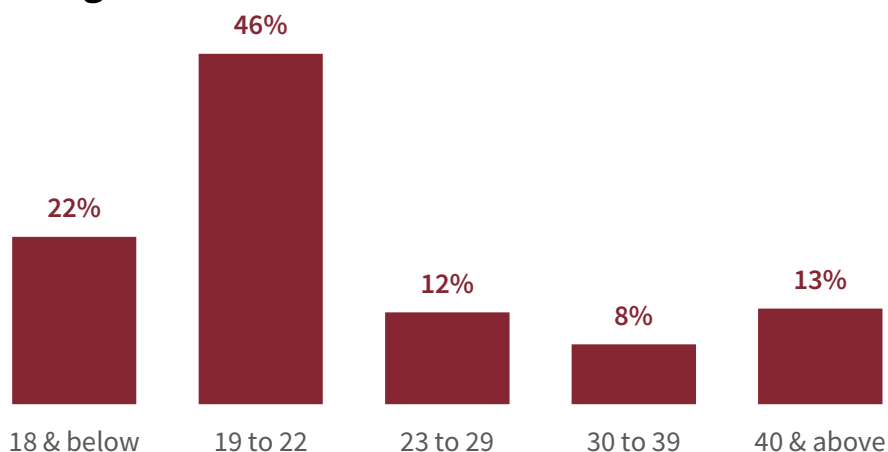
» Headcount



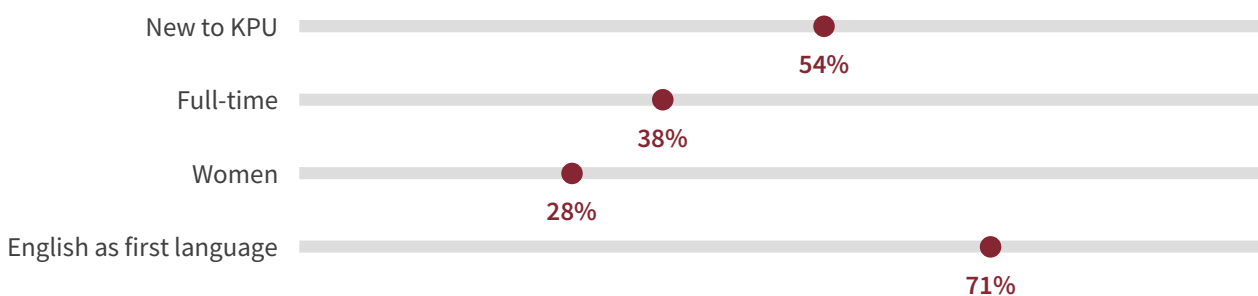
» Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)



» Age Distribution of Students

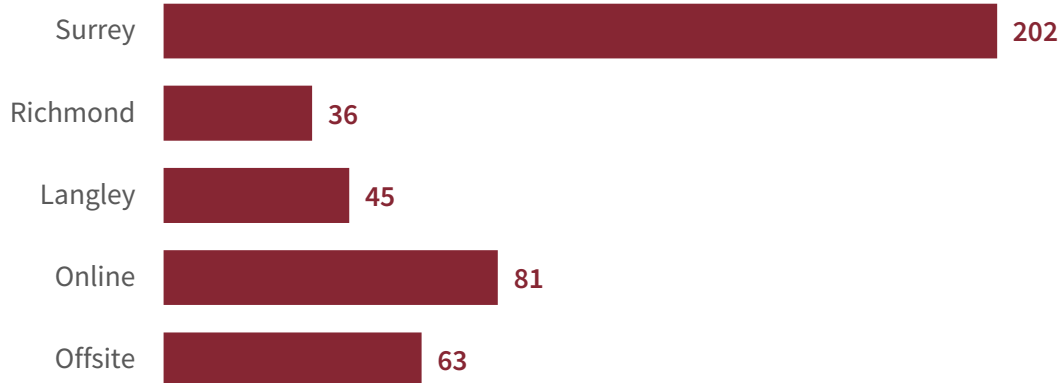


» Key Student Demographics

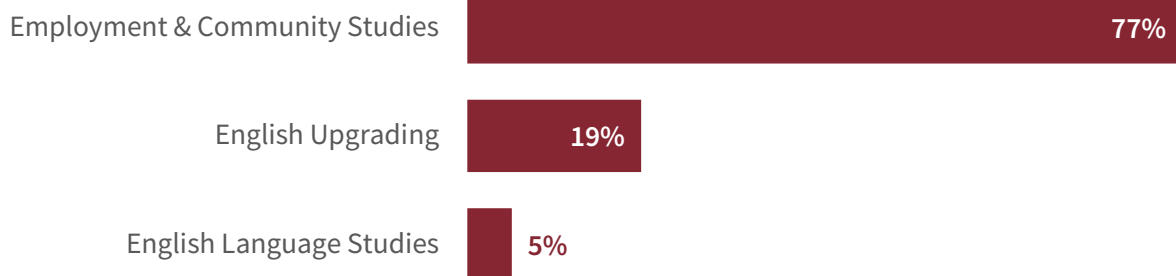


» Class Campus

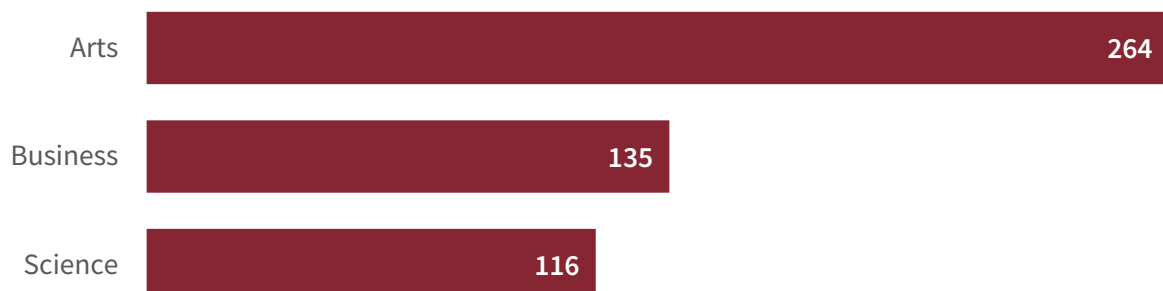

» Pathway to Undergraduate Studies Headcounts

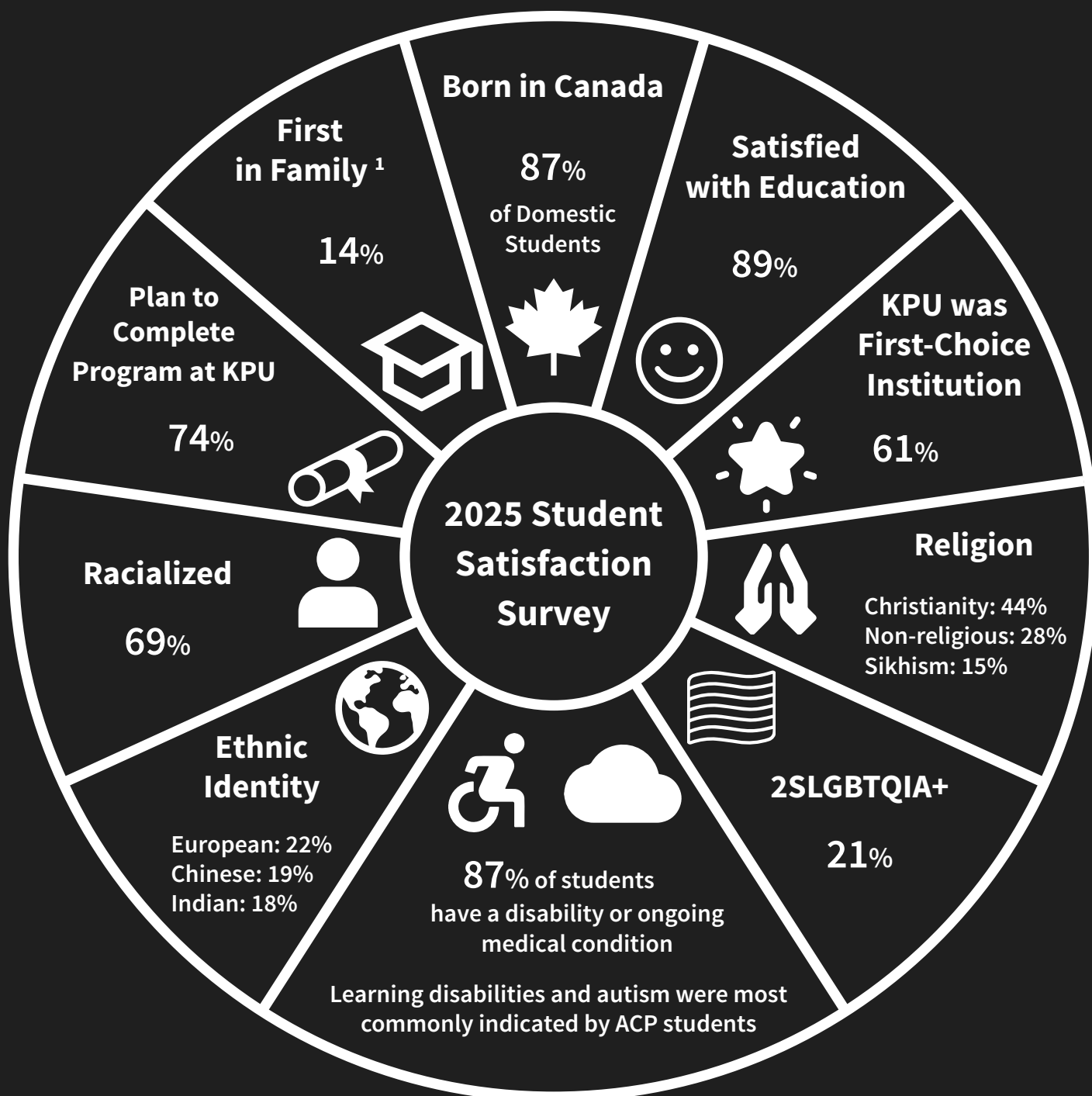

What Academic & Career Preparation Students Tell Us

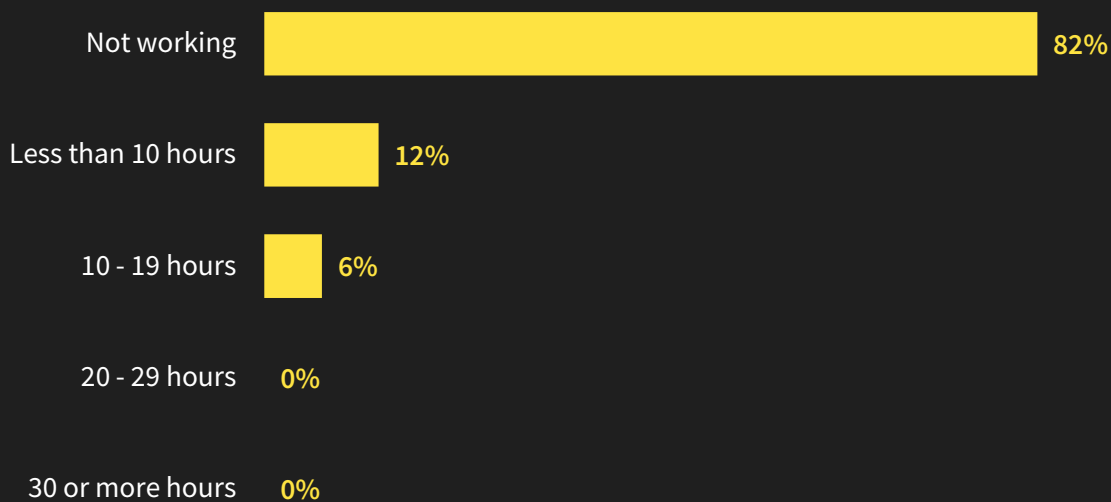
Of 119 eligible ACP students, 40 (34%) participated in the annual Student Satisfaction Survey in fall 2025.

Excluding responses from students who preferred not to answer or did not understand the questions. Unless specified, data is not broken down by domestic/international status due to low number of international student responses.

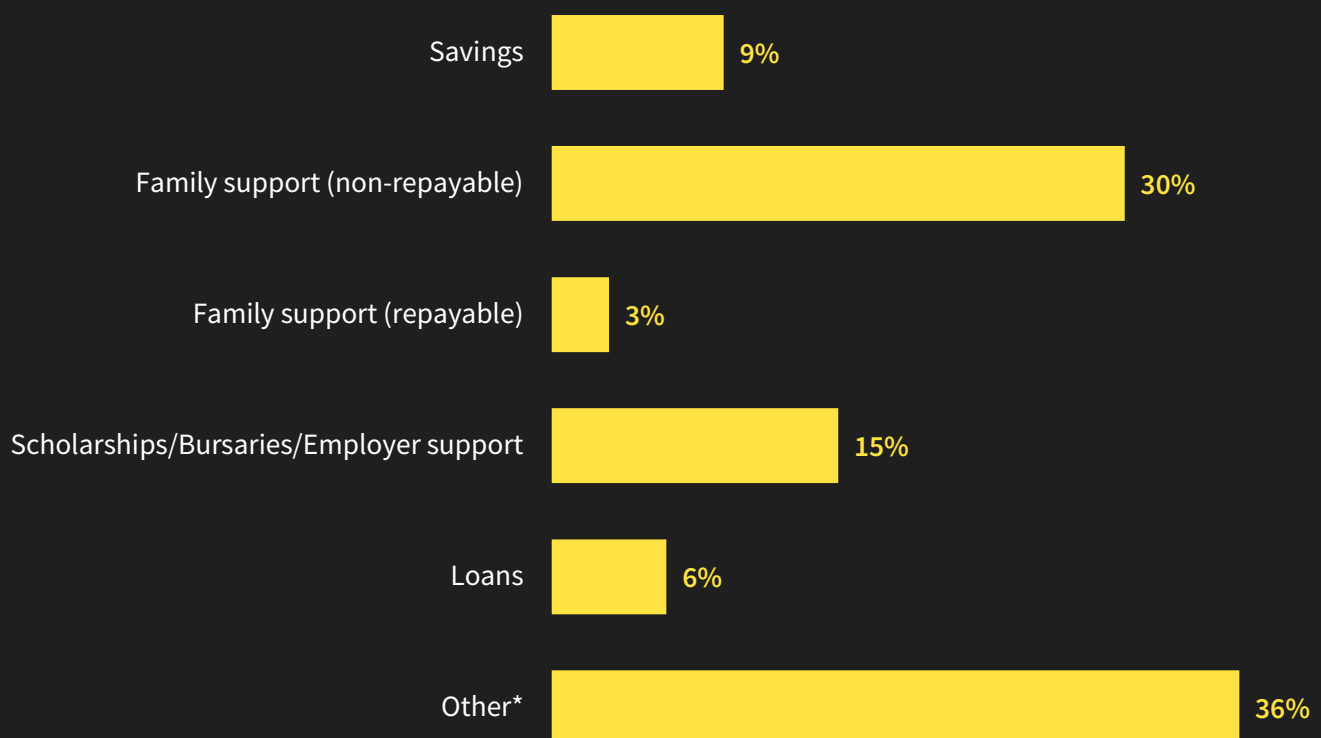


¹ **First in Family** students are those whose parents did not attend post-secondary education or formal trades training.
