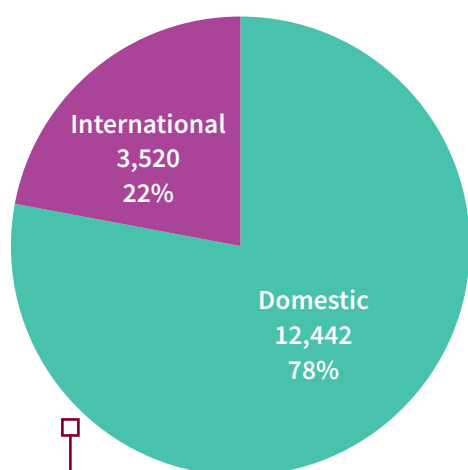

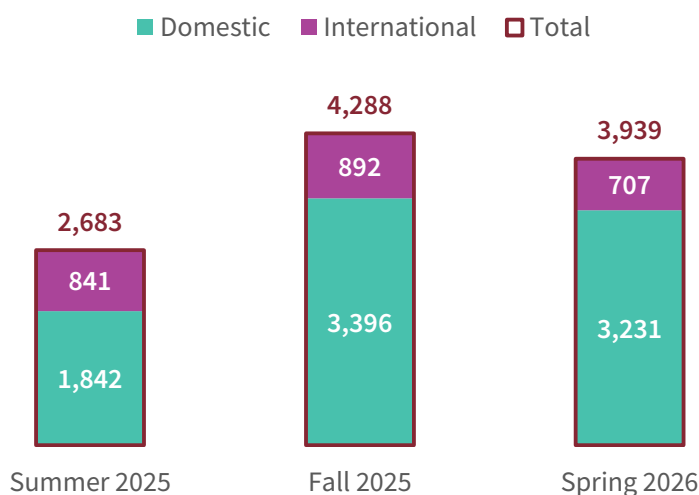

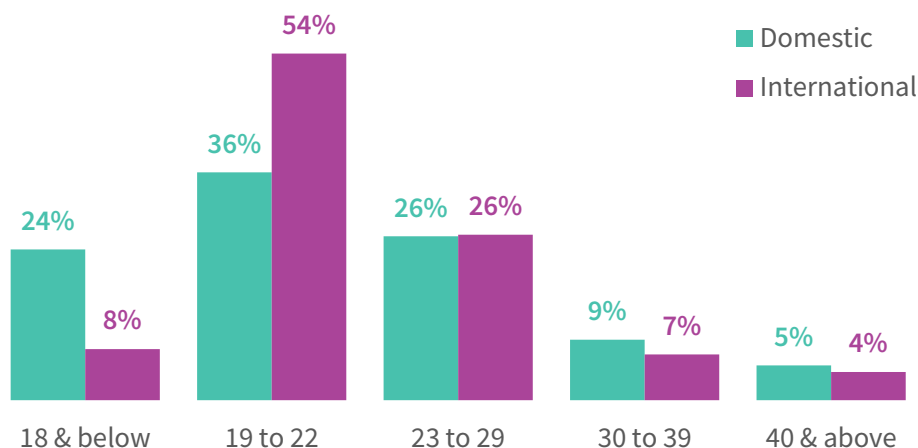

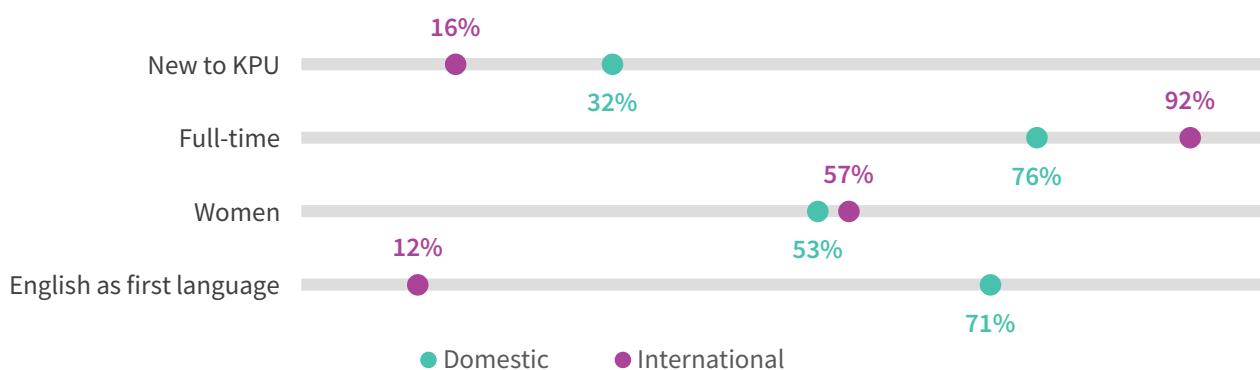
» Full-Time Equivalent (FTE)



» Age Distribution of Students

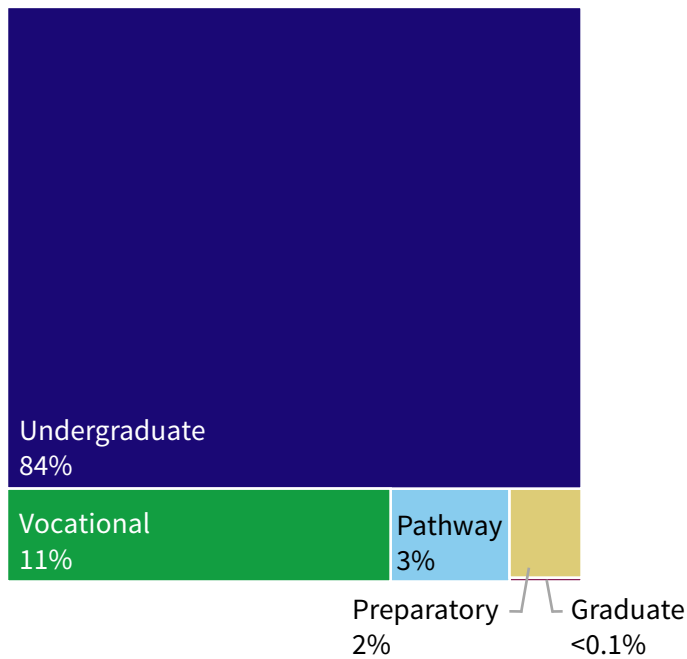

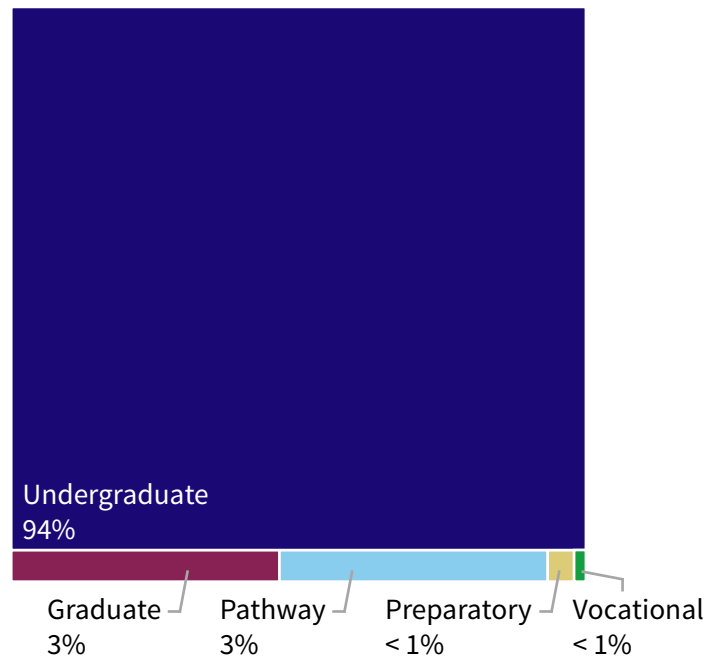

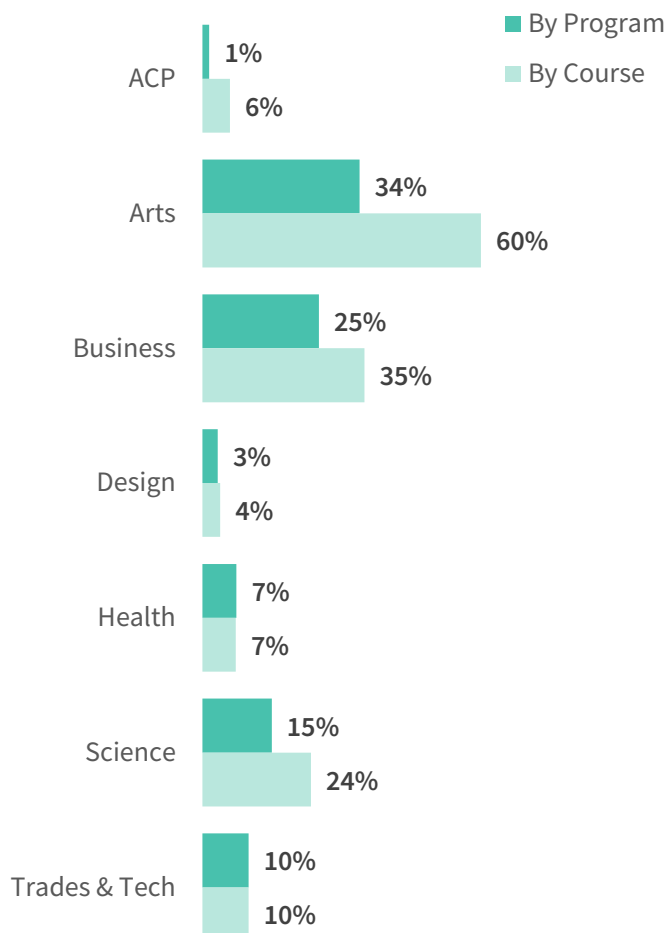

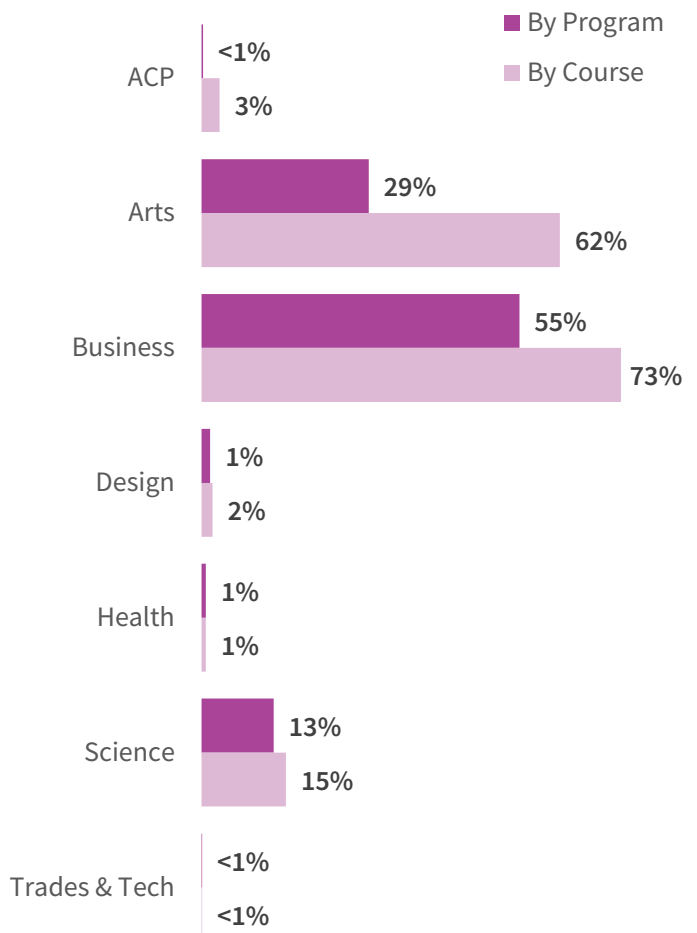
» Distribution of Students by Faculty

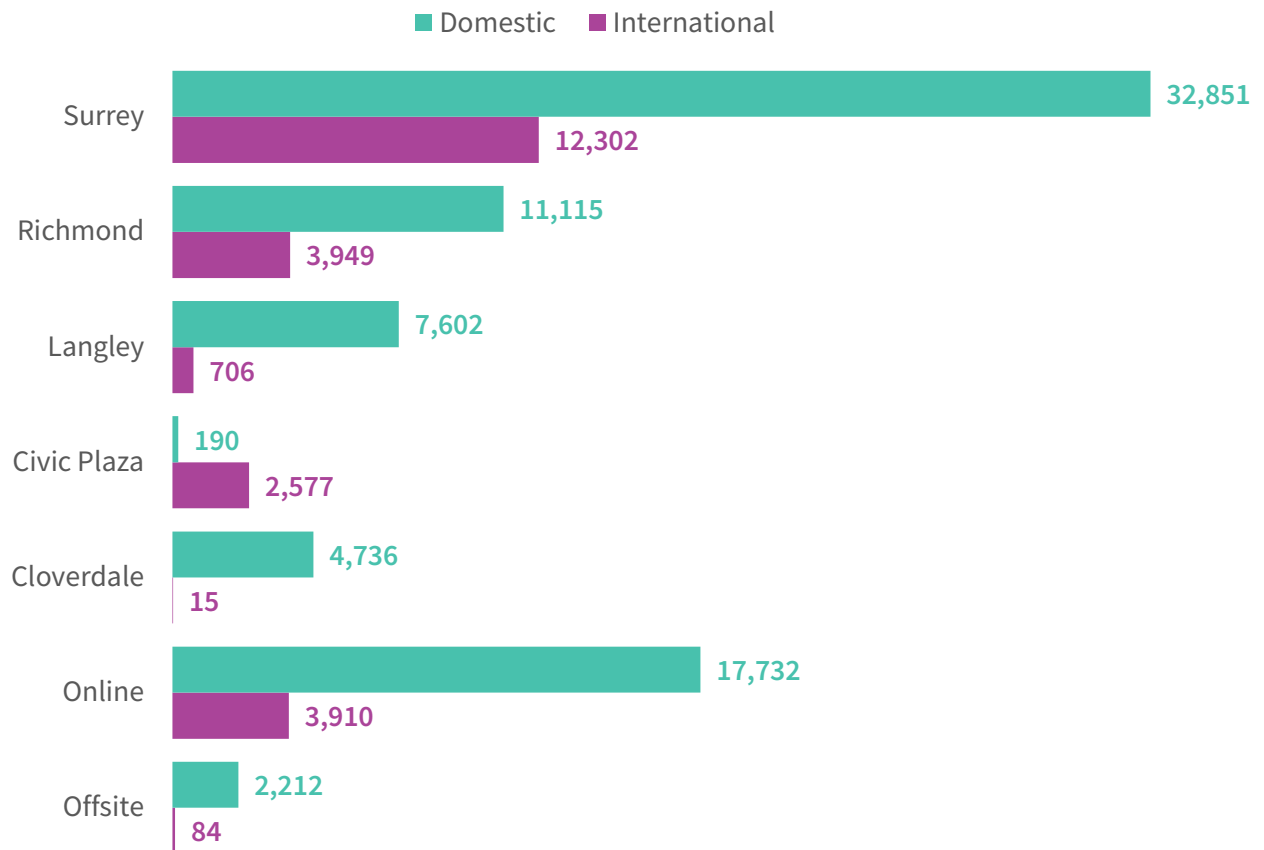

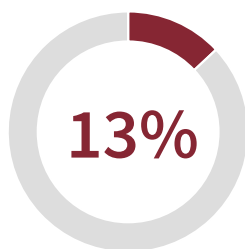
» Class Campus

Number of seats filled at each location. Students can take classes on more than one campus.

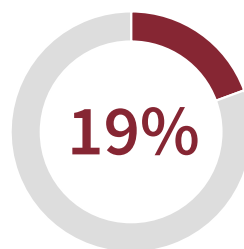


» Students Attending Multiple Campuses

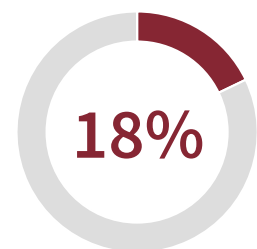
» By Semester

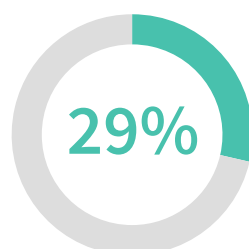

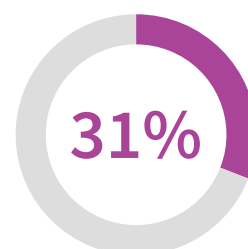

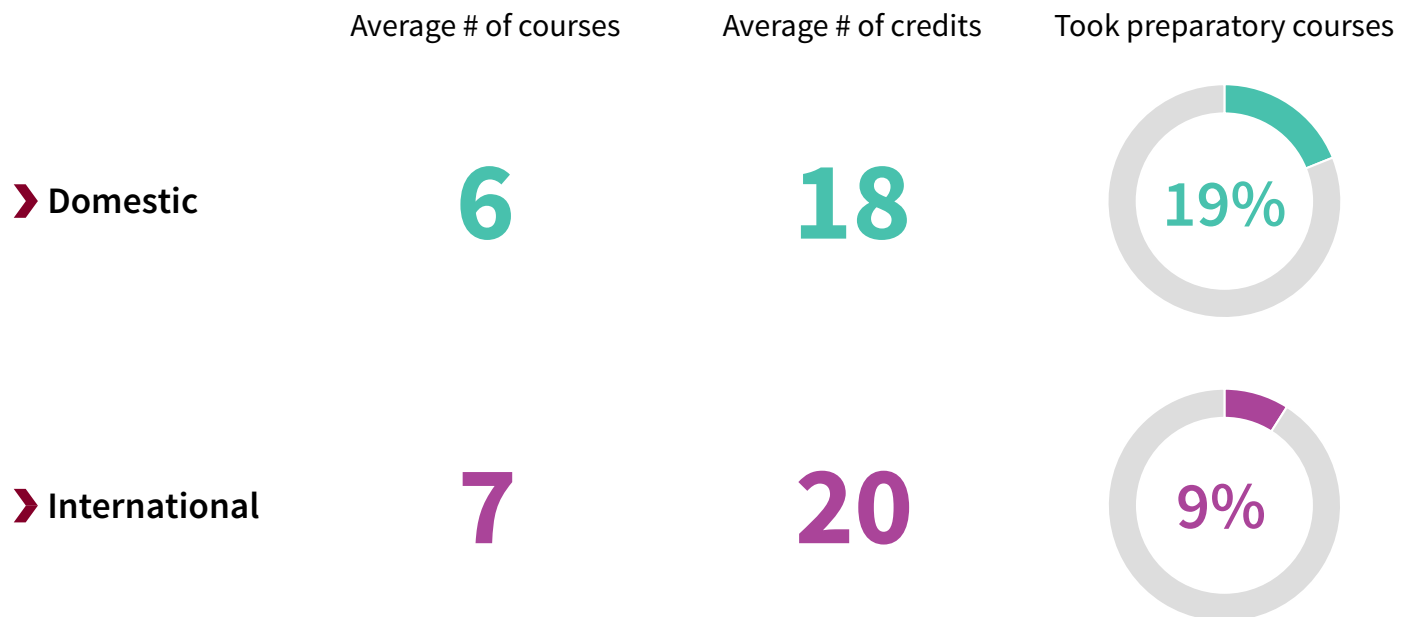

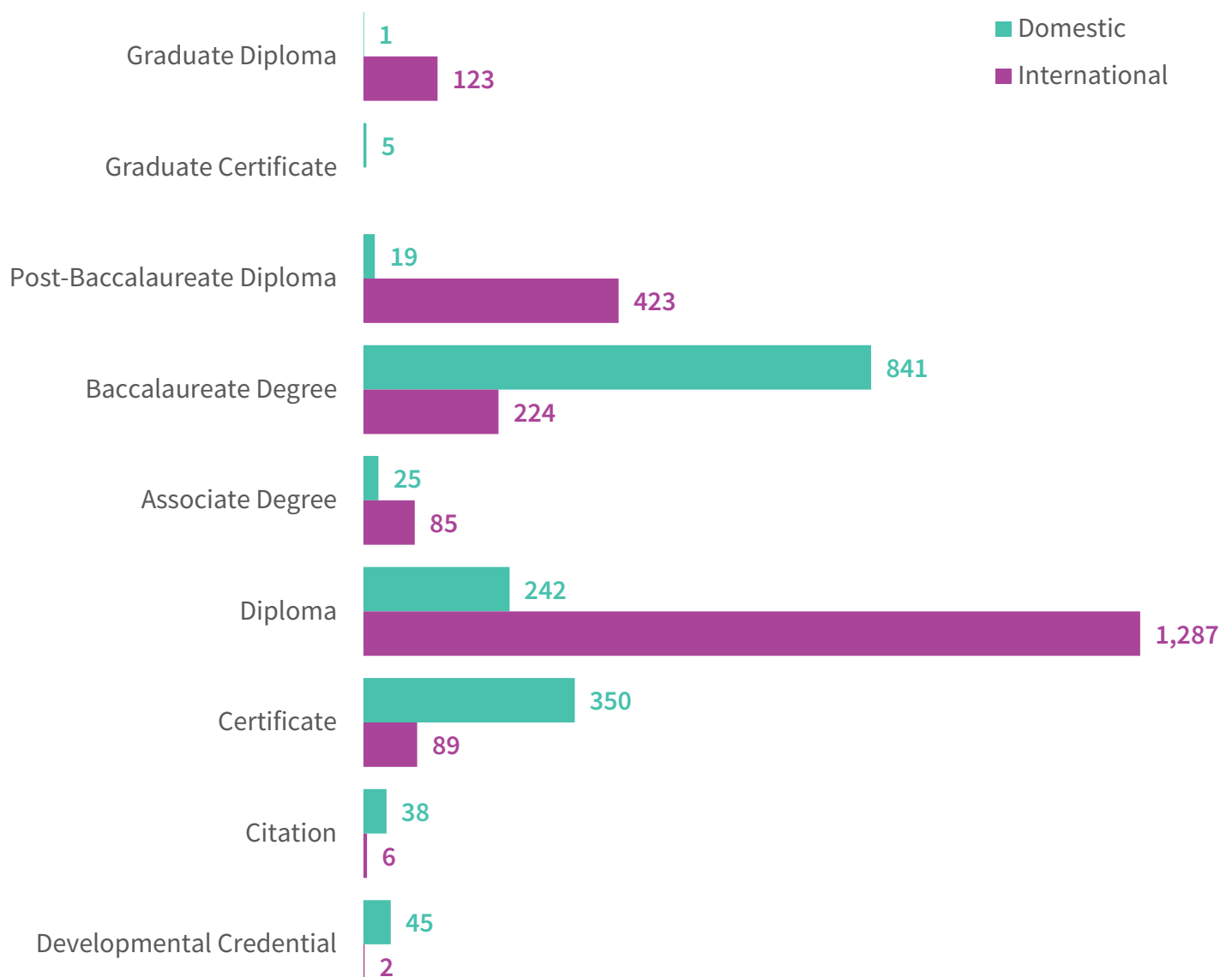

» Student Enrolment Patterns



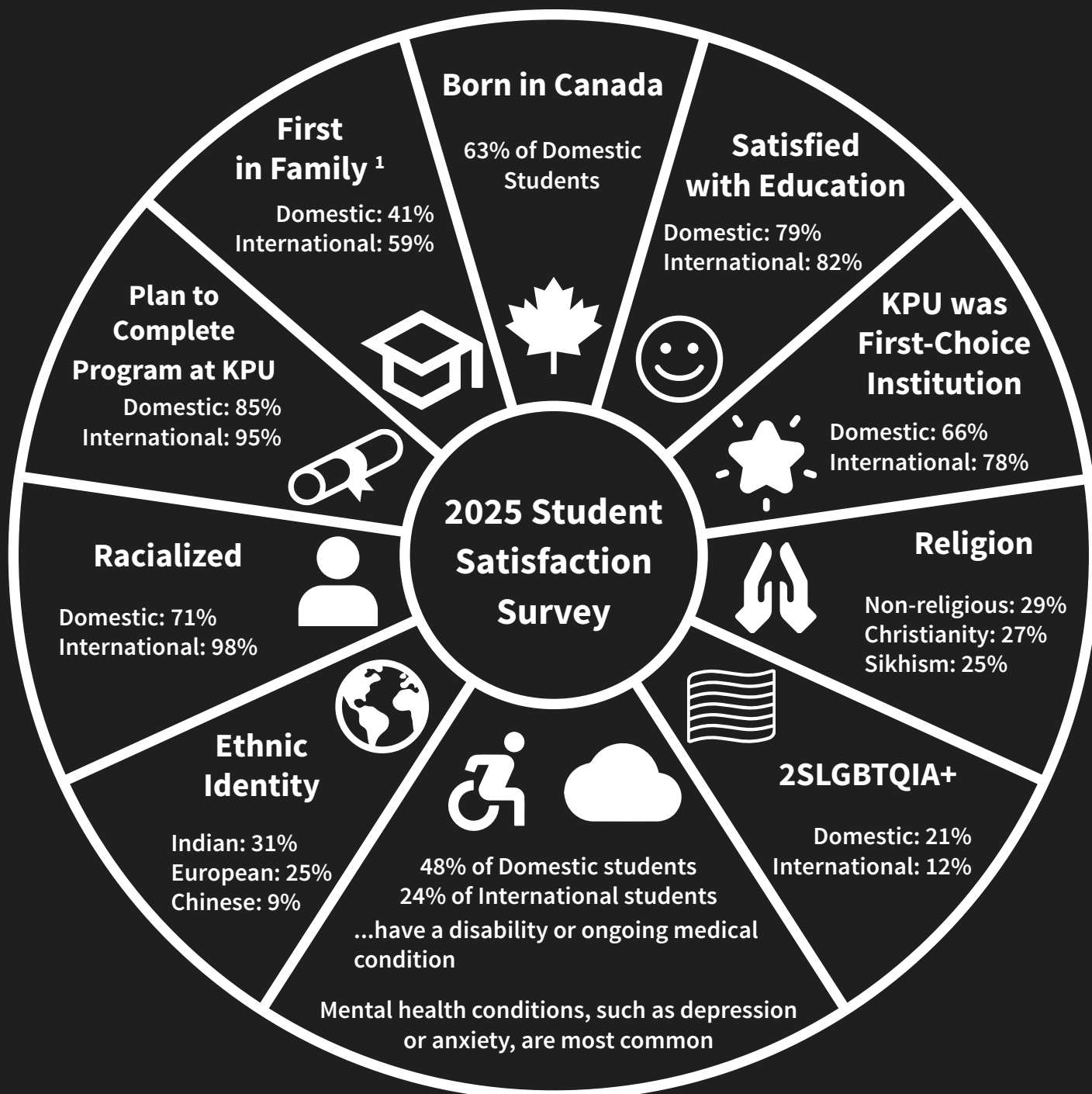
» Number of Graduates by Credential Type



What KPU Students Tell Us

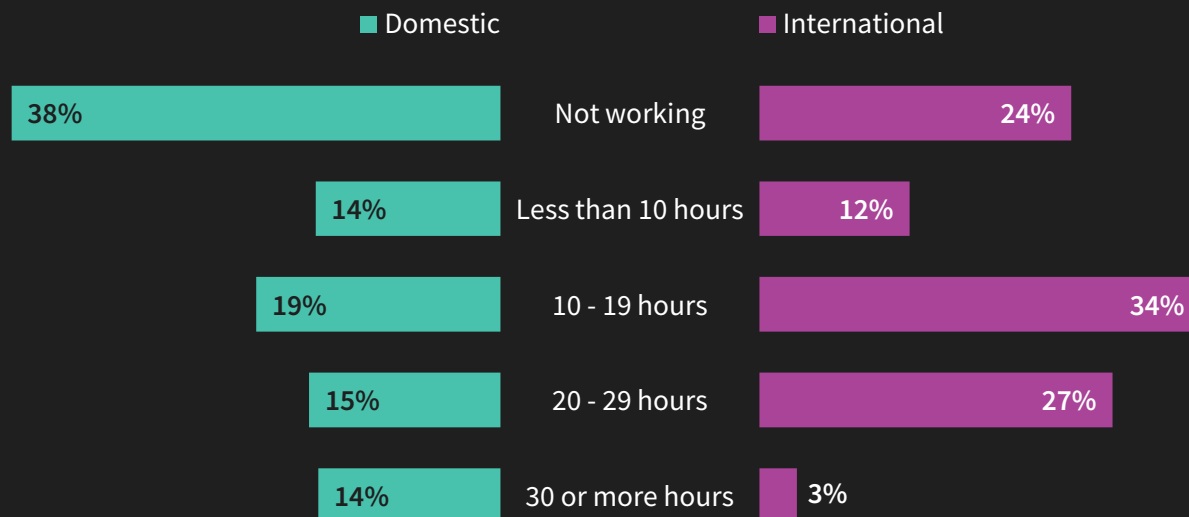
Over 3,900 KPU students participated in the annual Student Satisfaction Survey in fall 2025.

Excluding responses from students who preferred not to answer or did not understand the questions.

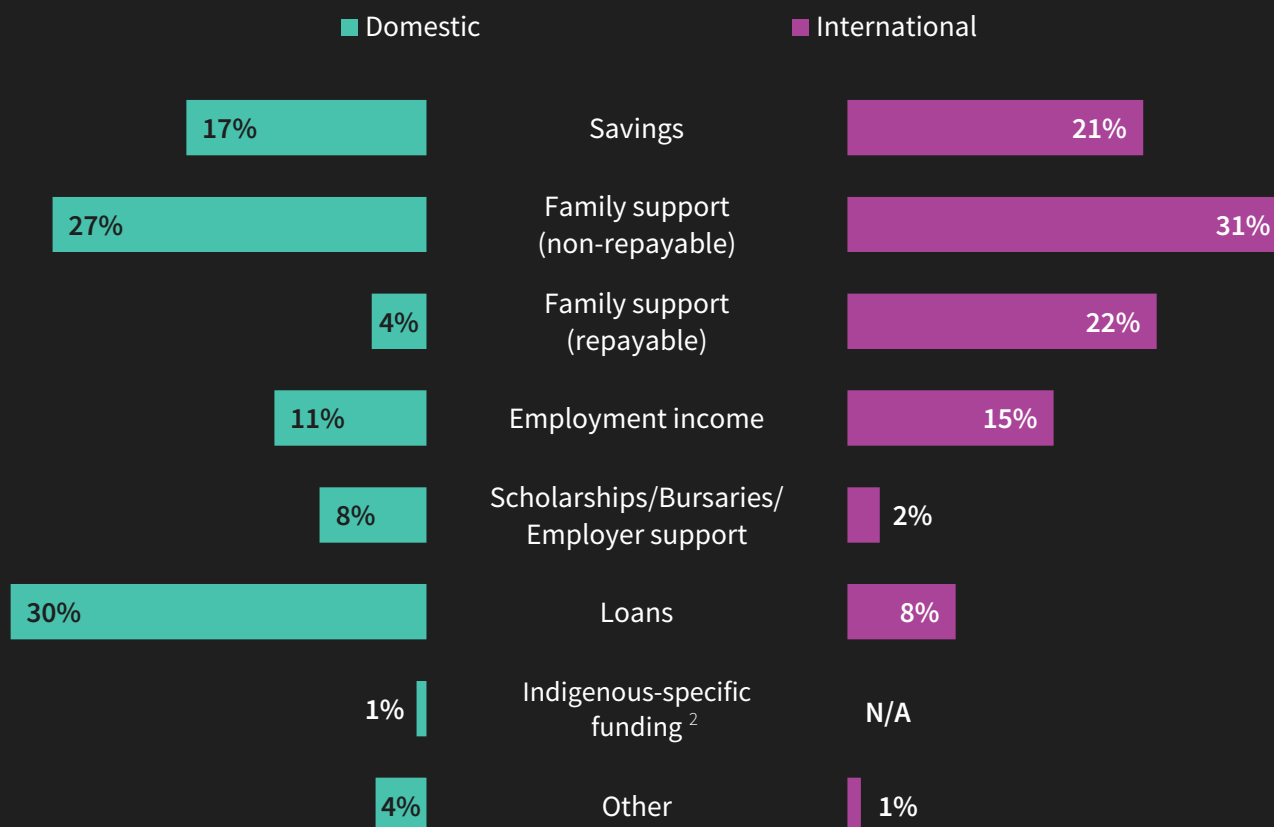

» Top Funding Source for Education & Living Expenses

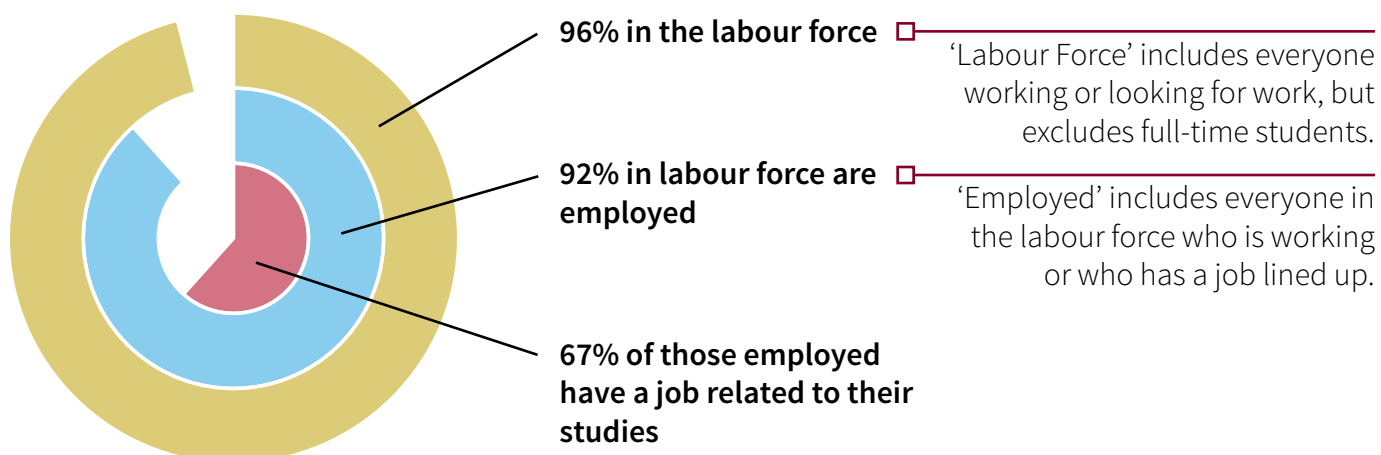

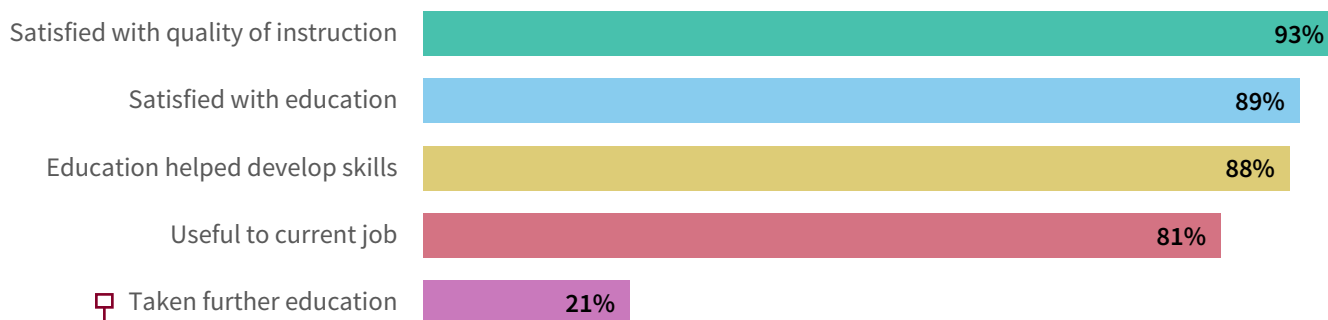
How KPU Graduates Do
