

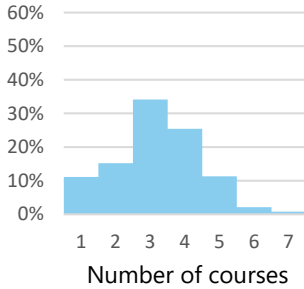

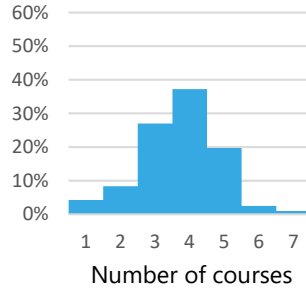

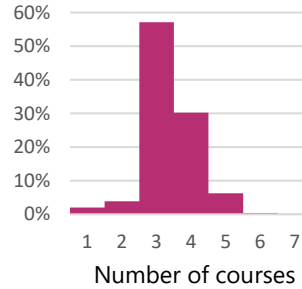

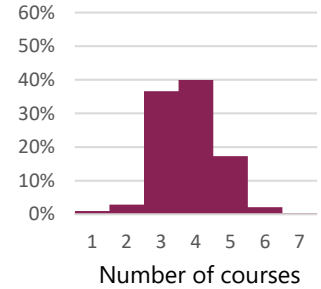

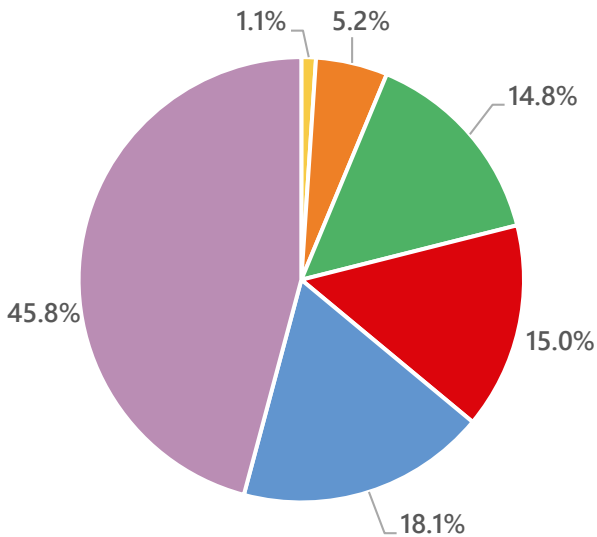

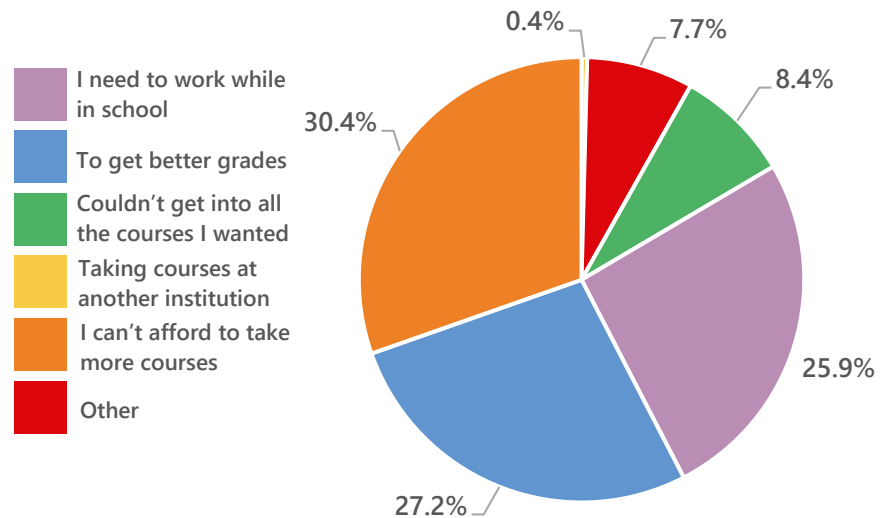
## What is the main reason you are taking fewer than 5 courses?

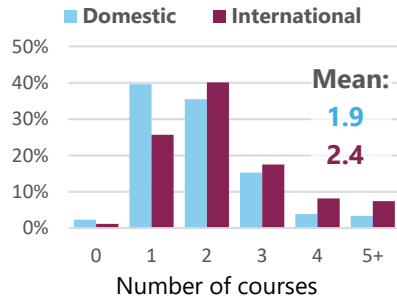

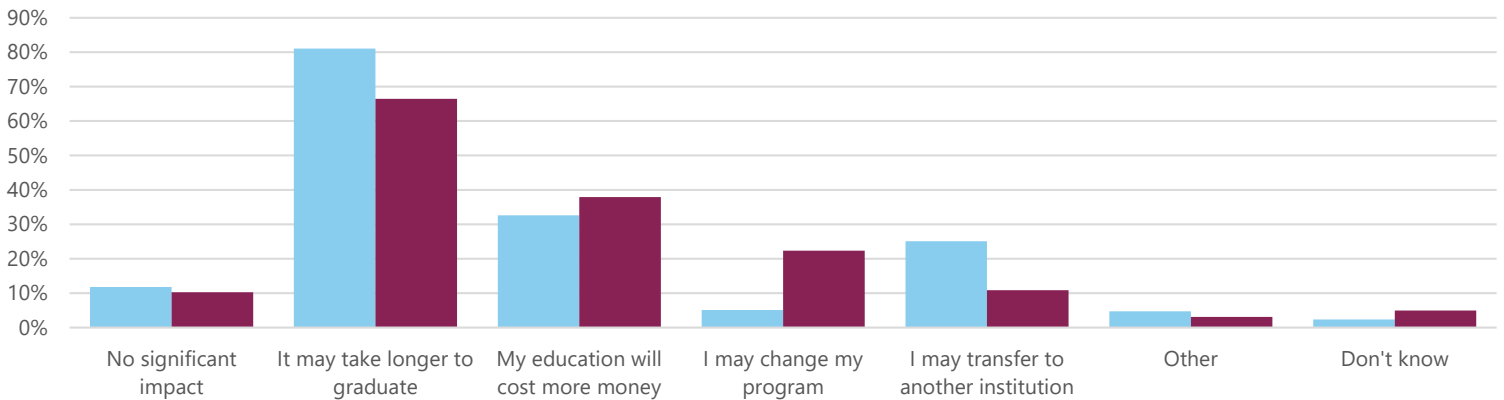
