Social Insurance Number (SIN) Workshop

Don't have your SIN yet? Join us for an [in-person workshop](#) to learn about the SIN application process and apply right on campus!

A Service Canada representative will provide an overview of the Social Insurance Number (SIN), and explain why it's important for working in Canada, and assist eligible students with submitting their SIN application during the session. All students—both domestic and international—need to update their SIN with KPU so the university can issue the [T2202A](#) tuition tax form. Students include the T2202A when filing taxes in Canada each year.

If you plan to apply for your SIN at the workshop, please bring your **original Study Permit** and **passport/other valid government-issued identification**
