Broken links in new Moodle?

You may have heard that this move resulted in broken links to media within the Moodle courses. For those who taught summer semester can attest, it has been extra work to re-link media in your course(s) on the new Moodle sites because Kaltura video on [courses.kpu.ca](#) does not work in the new Moodle sites. We have been working with a third-party vendor to fix these links and will provide a detailed update after August 1st.

For those who are moving a back-up of your course from [courses.kpu.ca](#) for the first time into [courses.moodle.kpu.ca](#), we advise to wait for our next update after August 1st.
