Registration for Fall 2026!

The registration portal for the Fall 2026 semester opens on **Monday, July 13, 2026**. Your specific registration date and time will vary based on your program, credits completed, and Academic Standing.

Before choosing your courses, international students are strongly encouraged to meet with an [International Student Advisor](#) for course planning.

International Advising Drop-In Sessions

KPU International Advising will be offering **drop-in services at 1:30 PM – 4:00 PM on Wednesday, July 8 (In-person), and on Friday, July 10 (Online)**. Simply join either one of the sessions and speak with an International Student Advisor to get answers to your questions and support with your student journey.

Need help with course planning? For example, if you are a Science or Horticulture student and need guidance on meeting Math prerequisite requirements for first-year science courses, an advisor can help you explore options such as taking the Math Placement Test (MPT) or enrolling in qualifying Math courses.



Travel Reminder: Check Your TRV/eTA

Planning to travel outside Canada? Before you leave Canada, **make sure your Temporary Resident Visa (TRV) or Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA) is valid for re-entry**. Because, even with a valid Study Permit, you may be denied entry to Canada if your TRV or eTA has expired.

To help you prepare for a smooth return to Canada, we have compiled several **TRV/eTA-related resources** available on both the [KPU International Advising website](#) and the [IRCC website](#). These resources provide information on eligibility, application procedures, and how to renew your TRV or apply for an eTA. Safe travels, and we look forward to welcoming you back to KPU!

Tuition Deposit and Cost Overview

Each international student, who wants to register a course in the upcoming Fall semester, is required to pay a \$2,200 tuition deposit, which is credited toward their total tuition and is not an extra charge.

To ensure timely registration, please submit your payment at least **five business days before your registration date**.
