File your 2024 taxes by Apr 30, 2025

As an international student in Canada, you may need to file a Canadian income tax return. Your residency status, based on your residential ties to Canada, determines how you will be taxed.

Meet these **Key Tax Deadlines** to avoid penalties:

- April 30, 2025: Deadline to file and pay your taxes.
- June 16, 2025 (since June 15 is a Sunday): Deadline if you or your spouse/common-law partner are selfemployed.
