1) Access to Global Learning Award

As part of the funding from the Employment and Social Development Canada's Outbound Mobility Pilot Program Innovation Fund (as administered by Colleges and Institutes of Canada (CiCan), KPU created a needs-based and character-based Access to Global Learning Award that follows the aim to address inequality and representation in outbound student mobility through inclusive policy and practices.

The funding is to widen access to global learning opportunities to KPU students by directly funding students of two categories:
