URGENT ACTION REQUIRED

Restructuring Moodle's infrastructure has been communicated multiple times in the past, and we are now at the final stage of our project where we must retire our old Moodle Site "[Courses.kpu.ca](#)" in accordance with our vendor's final requirement. As we have successfully transitioned to the new Moodle site [infrastructure](#), **after November 30th, all users will be unable to access the "[Courses.kpu.ca](#)" site.** We strongly recommend that you back up any courses that you may need in the future, and you can also restore the course backups to your current Moodle sites by following the instructions below:

We are not relocating all of the courses to their respective sites as part of the site cleanup process, and we greatly appreciate your understanding in this regard. Please note that, per KPU regulation, we only maintain backups for the previous two years.
