

# Information About Academic Accommodations in PNUR/PNCA Courses

To arrange your accommodations:

- Contact [KPU's Accessibility Services](#) as early as possible
- Whenever possible, ensure your accommodation plan is in place **before** your course starts.

**Exam Accommodations for Online, Self-Paced Courses (PNUR 9101, PNUR 9035, PNUR 9100, PNUR 9032, PNUR 9112, PNUR 9033, PNUR 9031, PNUR 9037 and PNUR 9038)**

If you are enrolled in one of the above noted online, self-paced theory courses and require additional time for exams due to disability, please keep in mind that you must first register with KPU Accessibility Services to receive exam accommodations through KPU Assessment and Testing Services.

- All extended time exams must be invigilated through [KPU's Assessment and Testing Services](#).
- If you live in the Lower Mainland, you should plan to travel to a KPU campus for in-person invigilation
- If you do not live in the Lower Mainland, it may be possible to arrange remote invigilation – please contact an Accessibility Services Learning Specialist early.
- **Invigilation must be booked two weeks in advance** – be sure to plan for your exam dates and give yourself sufficient time for a re-write, if necessary, as extensions to course end dates are not permissible.
