

League Policies and Procedures

Eligibility

Any current KPU student, faculty or staff member is eligible to participate in the league as long as registration permits. Restrictions apply to Kwantlen Eagles Athletes. Community members may join a team so as long as there are at least 3 KPU students or employees on the team. League team captains must be either a KPU student or employee.

Injured Players Eligibility

A participant who is injured before or during play and is not able to continue cannot be replaced by anyone other than members of his/her team past the start of regular season.

Refund Policy

A 100% refund will be given if a request is made prior to the registration deadline. No refunds will be given after the registration deadline. If you are required to withdraw due to a health related issue, you may apply for a refund. A doctor's note may be required before the refund will be issued.

All programs are subject to cancellation due to insufficient registration. Participants will be notified of the cancellation within 48 hours registration deadline and will be issued a full refund. Please allow up to 10 business days for any refund to be processed.

Team Wait List Policy

Teams and individuals register on a first come first served basis. Once the maximum number of spaces has been exceeded, teams in question are put on the waiting list. Although effort will be made to schedule teams on the Waiting List into competition, there is no guarantee that teams on the waiting list will be accommodated.

Waivers

Each player must sign a waiver prior to participation. Waiver forms are available online or are at the Fitness Desk for team captains to distribute to their players. Waivers are only collected at the first scheduled regular season game.

Player Photo ID

Each player must present their photo ID to the fitness desk and/or the KPU REC supervisor at every regular season game in order to gain access to the gymnasium. All students and employees must present their KPU Student Card or Employee card. Community members may present any government issued photo ID.

Time outs and substitutions

1. Each team is allowed one (1) one minute time-out per game.

2. Player substitution is permitted only during any dead ball situation.

Equipment and Uniforms

Every player must wear a numbered basketball jersey provide by KPU Rec before the start of each game. Jerseys must be returned in to the Fitness Desk after each game for washing. Unreturned jerseys may result in suspension of league and/or gym privileges. Athletic clothing and non-marking running shoes are required (indoor shoes preferred).

Equipment Regulations

The official or supervisor has the right to remove any piece of equipment, which is deemed dangerous or inappropriate for league play, including, but not limited to:

- a. Jewelry (this includes earrings, bracelets, necklaces, etc.) Exceptions: medical alert necklaces and bracelets.
- b. Orthopedic braces with exposed metal
- c. Towels attached to the players
- d. Any hooded shirt or sweatshirt

Photo/Media Release Policy

Photographers and videographers are often present to capture participation in KPU REC programs. The KPU REC league participation waiver includes a media/photo release that all players must sign prior to participation. In the event that a participant does not wish to have his or her photo/video footage used, it is his or her responsibility to notify the photographer or videographer.

Team Name Policy

KPU REC would like to encourage each team to select a name which will stay with that Unit (eg. KMA Mashers) into the future and which will identify that Unit.

In addition, when choosing a team name please:

- Ensure that the selected name is in good taste, and
- Ensure the name is not offensive to individuals or groups identified in the KPU Policy on Discrimination and Harassment.

The characteristics protected under the Policy are age, race, colour, ancestry, place of origin, political belief, religion, marital status, family status, physical or mental disability, sex, sexual orientation and unrelated criminal convictions. KPU REC reserves the right to refuse inappropriate names

Sportsmanship

Teams and players are expected to exhibit sportsmanlike conduct throughout every contest. Delay of the game, obscene language or gestures, and arguing with the staff constitutes unsportsmanlike behaviour. Players may be penalized, ejected from the game, or possibly suspended from further games depending on severity.
