### Letter of Intent Guidelines

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

Admission into the KPU Brewing and Brewery Operations diploma program is based on grades in the prerequisite high school courses (or equivalents) and letter of intent review. Our Admissions Selection Committee evaluates your letter of intent to assess your academic background, your experience, and your goals.

Once you have submitted your official transcript to the Admissions Office, please forward **one** email to [brew@kpu.ca](mailto:brew@kpu.ca) with your letter of intent attached, including:

- 1) A **letter**, of about 500 words in length, addressing:
  - your interest in attending the Brewing and Brewery Operations Program
  - the qualities you possess that make you a good candidate for this program
  - which completion option you're applying to\*:
    - Diploma: 2-year full-time
    - Diploma: 3- or 4-year part-time
    - Certificate
    - Micro-credential:
      - Beer Sensory Evaluation
      - Brewing
      - Brewing Science
      - Business of Brewing

*\*If you are interested in more than one completion option, please indicate your primary choice and explain your interest in each.*

Applicants who are currently upgrading high school requirements must submit proof of registration with their letter of intent.

Please quote your **full legal name** and **Student ID** number in the body of the email. Emails received without all required documents as outlined above will not be considered complete and will not be assessed for admission.

**Please note:** your letter of intent must be submitted electronically as outlined above by the deadline stated in the letter from the Admissions office.
