Statements that describe the learning that students can demonstrate at the end of an educational activity like a lesson, course, or program.

Components of Structurally Sound Learning Outcomes

Institutional Level

Meet ministry requirements, manage quality assurance processes

Instructional Level

Provide clarity around key competencies students will achieve in an educational experience, help instructors develop assessments, instruction to meet outcomes

Industry Level

Articulate the knowledge, skills and attitudes of a program's graduates who may be potential employees

Program Learning Outcome

PLOs state what the learner should be able to demonstrate doing or knowing in a measurable way at the end of their program of study.

Course Learning Outcome

CLOs speak to what the student will be able to do or know at the end of the course.

Lesson Learning Outcome

LLOs speak to what a student will be able to do or know at the end of the lesson.
