- » Other 2D work, such as drawings or paintings, photography, video or animation, process drawings from your sketchbook, journal or tablet.
- » Please do not include any character animation, 3D modelling, or animé.

Submit a video that helps us get to know you better by answering the outlined questions.

Unofficial Transcript(s)

Providing digital copies of any unofficial secondary and/or post-secondary transcripts will assist in the assessment of your entrance package.
