One course (3 credits) in the Foundations in Design Certificate, FIND 1220, can be applied to the Bachelor of Design in Graphic Design for Marketing.

- » English 12 with a min C+ (*or equivalent*)
- » Entrance package review

Entrance Package Requirements

Foundations in Design is a limited intake program. In addition to meeting KPU's general admission requirements, applicants must meet program specific requirements and submit an Entrance Package for review. Applicants will receive instructions on how to submit their online Entrance Package once they have completed the online application.



As part of the Entrance Package submission, applicants must submit:

1. A Video

The video should explain why you want to study at the Wilson School of Design and show relevant examples of your creative work. The format is up to you to showcase your current skills, and to answer questions provided by the program (see below). The video must:

- » Feature the applicant, be created and narrated by the applicant
- » Be a maximum length of 5 minutes
- » Be submitted as a video file (maximum 250 MB) or media link (YouTube or Vimeo)
- » Answer the following questions:
 - » Who are you? Introduce yourself.
 - » What are your current skills? Use examples of your work to explain. (Painting, drawing, photography, video/animation, sculpture, sewing/costume design, model making, etc.)
 - » Why design? What do you hope to learn from the Foundations in Design program?
 - » Who is your favourite designer? Why?

2. Transcripts

Please provide a copy of unofficial secondary and/or post-secondary transcripts. (*Official transcripts must be sent to Admissions.*)
