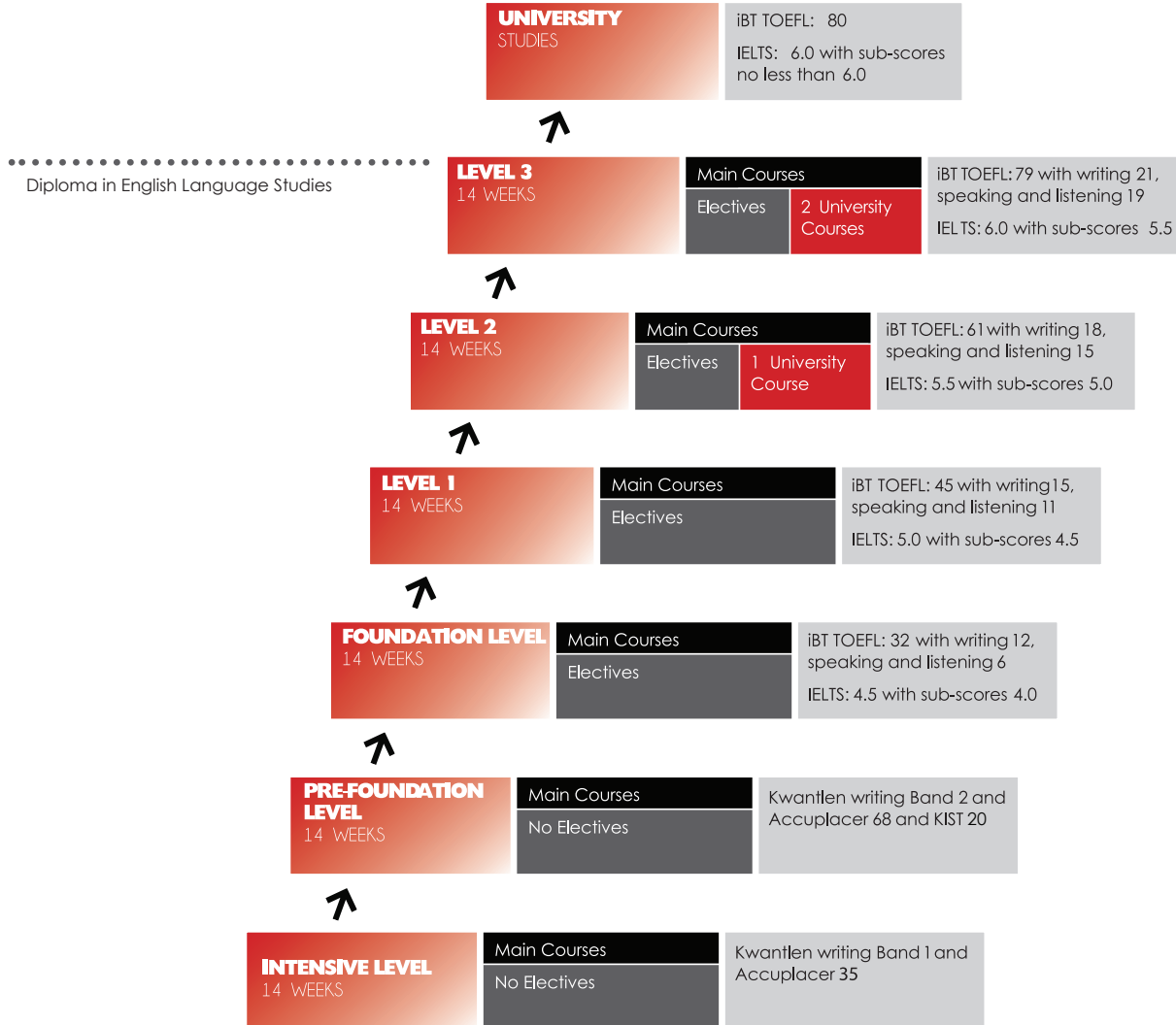

# GENERAL UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

# HOW TO APPLY

## 1. MEET THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

### UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES

Applicants to undergraduate programs are required to meet a minimum English language requirement of a C grade in English 12, English Literature 12, English 12 First Peoples, Communications 12, Technical Professional Communications 12, or equivalent. Refer to our online calendar at [kwantlen.ca/calendar/generalinfo/admission](http://kwantlen.ca/calendar/generalinfo/admission) for a detailed listing of equivalencies.

For certain undergraduate programs and courses, the English language requirement

may be higher. (Refer to the particular program sections of this book for further details).

### TRADES AND OTHER NON-UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

If you are applying to a trades or other non-undergraduate program, you are not required to meet the English language requirement as you will be assessed according to the requirements of your program. You may proceed directly to the next step.

### DON'T MEET THE ENGLISH REQUIREMENT?

Students who do not meet the English language requirement may be offered admission to:

- Adult Basic Education (ABE)
- University Qualifying Studies, or
- English Language Studies (ELST)

## 2. APPLY UNDER ONE OF THESE ADMISSION CATEGORIES:

### REGULAR UNIVERSITY ADMISSION

**High School Graduates:** If you have graduated from a B.C. secondary school or the equivalent from another school system, you are eligible.

**Mature Students:** If you have not graduated from a B.C. secondary school or the equivalent from another school system, and if you will be 19 years of age or older on the first day of attendance, you are eligible.

**College or University Transfer Students:** If you have completed post-secondary studies at another university or at a college, you are eligible.

### SPECIAL ADMISSION

**Underage:** If you have not graduated from a B.C. secondary school or the equivalent from another school system, and you will be 17 years of age or older on your first day of attendance at Kwantlen, and have not been in regular attendance at a secondary school for a minimum of one year, you may be admitted to Kwantlen in order to enrol in academic and career advancement.

**Concurrent:** If you are enrolled in Grade 12 at a B.C. secondary school in a program that meets the university admission requirements, you may be admitted to pursue concurrent studies.

**Other:** If you do not meet any of the above admission categories, you may appeal for special admission. You may be required to take testing and to attend an interview with the appropriate administrator to present reasons for requesting special admission and must provide supporting documentation as requested.
