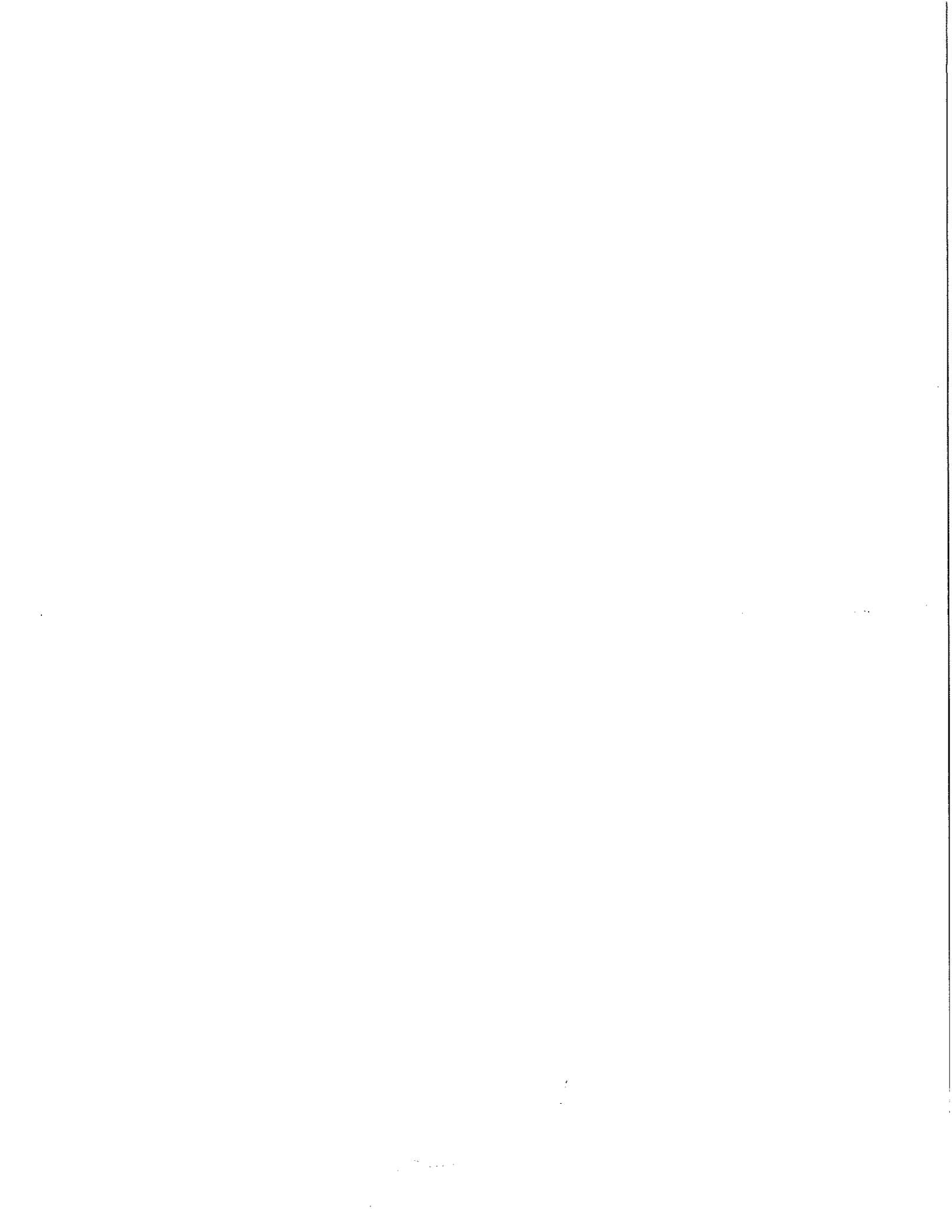
The original GOOD DESIGN founded in Chicago in 1950 program remains the oldest and most important Awards Program worldwide.


Additionally, the Award is being sent to the designers who made the submission. If your firm would like a copy of the Award, please see the attached and send directly to our office in Dublin, Ireland.
